



## Motorhome departure safety checks

- ✓ Internal articles - Ensure evenly distributed & secure
- ✓ Cab seats - Ensure locked facing forward
- ✓ External lockers & loads - Check secured
- ✓ Corner steadies - Raise (as required)
- ✓ Step - Retract/stow as required
- ✓ Check pitch is clear of your equipment before departing

## On the move

- ✓ Take care in high winds, poor weather conditions
- ✓ If you are slow moving allow other traffic to pass when safe to do so
- ✓ Be mindful of your size and overhangs
- ✓ Don't drive when tired, take frequent breaks
- ✓ Don't overload your motorhome, it is potentially dangerous and unlawful

## Motorhome safety pre-checks

Use this handy checklist whenever you're setting off in your motorhome

- ✓ Base vehicle checks - Oil, coolant, screenwash etc.
- ✓ TV aerial/Satellite dish - lower (if fitted)
- ✓ Mains electrics - Isolate
- ✓ Mains and TV cables - Disconnect & stow
- ✓ Fridge - set to 12V mode, check travel catch engaged
- ✓ Windows and roof lights - Check closed and locked, raise blinds
- ✓ Gas cylinder/s - Check secure & taps are closed at cylinder (Unless a crash switch is installed)
- ✓ Wheel nut torque and tyre pressures - Check
