



MOTORHOME SAFETY PRE-CHECKS

Use this handy checklist whenever you're setting off in your motorhome

- ✓ Base vehicle checks Oil, coolant, screenwash etc.
- ✓ TV aerial/Satellite dish lower (if fitted)
- Mains electrics Isolate
- ✓ Mains and TV cables Disconnect & stown
- Fridge set to 12V mode, check travel catch engaged
- Windows and roof lights Check closed and locked, raise blinds
- ✓ Gas cylinder/s Check secure & taps are closed at cylinder (Unless a crash switch is installed)
- √ Wheel nut torque and tyre pressures Check





MOTORHOME DEPARTURE SAFETY CHECKS

- ✓ Internal articles Ensure evenly distributed & secure
- Cab seats Ensure locked facing forward
- External lockers & loads Check secured
- Corner steadies Raise (as required)
- ✓ Step Retract/stow as required.
- Check pitch is clear of your equipment before departing

ON THE MOVE

- ✓ Take care in high winds, poor weather conditions
- If you are slow moving allow other traffic to pass when safe to do so
- Be mindful of your size and overhangs
- Don't drive when tired, take frequent breaks
- Don't overload your motorhome, it is potentially dangerous and unlawful
