About Sheriff Hutton

Sheriff Hutton campsite is located 9 miles from the historic town of York and 1.3 miles from the small village of Sheriff Hutton.

The site is mostly flat and open with a tree line boundary around the site.

The site offers a mixture of grass only, grass with electric and hardstanding with electric pitches, as well as Ready Camp tents.



A play area is situated in the centre of the site.

Mobile signal is reasonable on site. There is no payphone on site.

Television signal is quite good depending on equipment.

Assistance dogs are permitted in all buildings.



Your Arrival on Site

The earliest arrival time on site is strictly 1pm. Anyone arriving before this time will be asked to return later or park in the designated waiting bay down on the drive up to wards reception to avoid congestion occurring on the approach/exit road to site.

Approach surface is tarmac. Site is sign posted with a brown sign on opposite side of road to the site, and a large club sign outside main entrance.

Arrival surface is level tarmac, with a sign for reception and a "please remember" sign. There is a designated parking spaces for visitors and second cars, which is opposite office and available between 7am and 11pm.

There is a bus stop 1.2 miles from site in the village of Sheriff Hutton. This bus stop is on routes to York, Malton and Pickering.

There is a railway station at York 10.1 miles from site, which is on the East Coast Main Line.

Accessible taxis can be booked in advance on 01904 65 65 (Streamline Taxis York).



Your Check In

The reception block is the building on the left as you drive in and just ahead of the barrier. The reception is clearly signed.

Access to Reception is via a slight incline from the level tarmac road, which leads up to the reception building itself and is wheelchair accessible.

There is a small threshold into Reception. There is a 170 cm wide 204cm high archway with a shallow ridge at the bottom and the door opens inwards and is 87cm wide and 200cm high. The floor space is free from clutter and there is turning room for wheelchairs.

The reception is open from 9:00am – 10:30pm and 4:00pm – 6:00pm.



When reception is unattended there is a sign on the main door to reception explaining where site staff are or a phone number to ring. The latest assisted pitching is 8pm. Campers may self-pitch after this time up until 11pm - instructions for this are outside of the reception block.

Staff are not on duty after 8pm but an emergency telephone number is provided for blue light emergencies after this time. This phone number can be found printed on your Site Welcome Leaflet.

Details of local hospitals, doctors, dentists and vets can be found on the noticeboard outside reception and in the Site Welcome Leaflet.



Your Pitch

Hardstanding with electricity pitches are available close to the facility block, including accessible facilities.

The hardstanding pitches are gravel.

There are slightly sloping pitches at the top of the site where chocks may be required.

Campers can park on their pitch or at the left-hand side grass, weather permitting. There is a limit of 1 car per pitch. Additional vehicles can park opposite office or in the visitor parking layby situated on main driveway into the site.



Travelling Around Site

All site roads are tarmac. There is a speed limit around the site of 5 mph and there are speed bumps. A one-way system is in operation, and this is clearly signed.

The majority of the footpaths throughout the site are tarmac roads and tarmac paths are situated around toilet block. Handrails are in place around toilet block which is situated to the left of site and central.

There is low level bollard lighting on the site roads. A torch is recommended when walking around the site at night.

Beware, there are rabbit holes on the site.



The Facility Block



There is a clear, well-maintained path leading to the facility block. There are no steps on the pathway or to the facility block.

The ladies door width is 86 cm wide and 197cm high.

The gents door width is 86 cm wide and 197cm high.

The taps are push button.

The showers are push button but are not controllable showers. There are no steps in the showers. There are wall mounted seats in the drying area of the showers, but there are no free-standing seats in the actual showering area.

The facility block and access are well lit at night.

There is no turning room in the main facilities block for wheelchairs. There are no accessible cubicles.



The Accessible Facilities

There is slight slope which levels off leading to the accessible facilities, which are located at the side of the reception block, having its own door opening directly onto the pathway. There are no handrails leading to the facility.

The door has an 875mm opening width and opens outwards. There is a grab rail by the door on the inside and outside. The facilities are accessed via a patio slabbed path. There is a pull handle on the door.

The taps are lever.

The shower is open access, flat wet room style with no tray to step into. The shower has two grab rails and a pull-down seat, capable of taking a weight up to 130kgs. It is a turn control to operate, and the shower head is height adjustable.

The toilet has drop down handrails on both sides. The toilet has a larger flush handle. There is transfer space to the left of the toilet when you are looking at it and handrails are lifted. There is a hand dryer, and the washbasin is at the side of toilet but cannot be reached from the toilet. The floor is non-slip.

There is an emergency cord by the toilet and at the side of the shower that can be reached from the floor. The alarm can be heard from the staff pitches and reception.

The mirror dimensions are 40cm x 60 cm and is 80cm high from the floor.





Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

These areas have good level access and are located at the main facilities block. The dishwashing area is at the front of the block and the laundry at the back. There are no handrails leading to these areas or within the areas. There is wheelchair turning room in the laundry, also turning room in the dishwashing. The door to the laundry opens outwards and is 76cm wide and 197cm tall.

The taps are push button.

Sinks are high in the laundry, but in dishwashing area there are two low level measuring 73cm in hight and four high sinks measuring 85cm high.

The dishwash areas do not have doors, it's just a large opening measuring 149cm wide and 192cm high.

There are coin operated washing machines and tumble dryers. There is one washing machine and one tumble dryer. They are not stacked and are both front loading.



Recreational Areas

There is an outdoor play area.

This is situated in the centre of the site with flat, level access over the grass. There is seating available near the play area. Play area surface is wet pour and is surrounded by grass. There is a swing, a baby swing, a slide, and a climbing slope with a slightly raised edge surrounding the area together with a low fence.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is flat, level access leading to the refuse area, which is situated to the side of the main reception area. The path is paved. There are no handrails.

The waste bins are 131cm high with lids (so may be difficult for someone it a wheelchair).

There is flat, level access to all water taps (no lifting required).

There is flat, level access to all waste points (no lifting required).

The site has a CDP. There is flat level access but once outside the CDP there is a step 20 cm high, which is situated at the front end of main facilities. There is a grab rail on the wall outside the CDP



by the door. There is a small basin and soap dispenser in the CDP. Containers need to be lifted to a height of 72cm to be emptied.

There are fire triangles on site. There is unrestricted access to the firefighting equipment.

Fire assembly points are opposite office and in the layby on main driveway into site and are marked on the Site Welcome Leaflet.



Ready Camp Tents, Pods and Other Accommodation

There are Ready Camp tents on site.

There is access from reception to the Ready Camp tents with no handrail. The road is tarmac. The path is grass.

The Ready Camp tents are approximately 75m from the nearest facility block via a grass area and paving.

There is a step up into each Ready Camp tent of 20cm from a grassed area. A portable ramp is available from reception (subject to availability). The Ready Camp tent entrance is canvas and can be clipped back to the full width of the tent if necessary. There is some turning space inside the tent for a wheelchair but may be restricted in some areas depending on how furniture is arranged (the sofa, table and chairs are movable).

There is no room for a wheelchair either side of the double bed in the first bedroom, but limited access is possible to the double bed in the second bedroom when the pull-out single bed is not being used.

There are 3 power points in the Ready Camp tents.

The double beds are 48cm high to the top of the mattress. The single bunk is 130cm from the ground to the top of the matter, is above the double bed in the second bedroom and is accessed by a fixed ladder. The single pull-out bed is 27 cm high to the top of the mattress.

The kitchen unit is 95cm high.

The sofa is to cushion 38cm high.

The table is 75cm high.

The flooring is flat and of wooden construction with a vinyl covering.

There is one parking space (on grass) for each ready camp which is located to the side of each Ready Camp.
