Your Arrival on Site

- O Train station is 1 mile from site. Bus stop is ½ mile from site
- There is 1 brown sign on the A671 and 1 brown sign on Edisford road. 1 Large site sign at the entrance to lane
- One keypad operated barrier on the entrance and one automatic barrier on exit. Both lock automatic between 11pm and 7am
- o Tarmac road on approach to site and on site
- Visitor parking is just outside entrance barrier, also if you go out in your vehicle and arrive back after 11pm
- o New arrivals should pull up to reception. The surface is tarmac and is level
- No accessible parking space, but anyone with a disability can park where the visitor parking is just outside entrance barrier
- o Ramp with handrail leading to reception gentle incline
- Steps on one side of reception
- Potted plants are kept out of the way

Your Check in

- The reception is clearly signed for Arrivals
- Opening hours 9am 10.30am and then 1pm 5pm
- There is a bell located on the reception door from 5pm 8pm after this time there is a notice with a telephone number on for emergencies
- Slight incline concrete path
- 50mm threshold on reception doorway
- Good clear floor space
- No low level reception counter, but clipboards are available

Your Pitch

- o Cars can be parked next to most pitches on site
- 3 pitches close to accessible room
- o Hardstanding pitches have got plastic matting under the grass
- o A few hardstanding level pitches and a few grass pitches most sloping are near the facilities

Your Facilities

- o There is a clear well maintained path leading to facilities
- There is no step to the first facility block. The second facility block you have to step up at the door into the block
- There is a gentle incline ramp to both blocks
- o There is no semi ambulant cubicle in the facilities
- o Are the taps mixture of both screw and push top
- o There are no seats within the showers but there are stools
- Showers are operated by a push button
- Showers are level, there is no step
- The facility block is lit outside at night

Your Accessible Facilities

- o There is a ramp with a slight incline leading to the accessible facility
- There are handrails leading to the accessible facility. As you approach the right handrail is wall mounted and the left is free standing
- There is flat level access in to the accessible facility
- The toilet has drop down handrails
- o The toilet has a larger flush handle
- As you're looking at it, there is transfer space to the left of the toilet
- The wash basin cannot be reached from the toilet
- The washbasin tap is a large lever top
- o There is a hand dryer in the room
- o There is a large mirror just above the wash basin it is not full length
- The shower has two handrails
- The shower is dial operated
- o The shower is open access
- o The shower head height is adjustable
- o The floor is non-slip
- o There is not a hair dryer in this facility
- There is an emergency chord next to the toilet and the shower, both can be reached from the floor
- o The alarm can be heard from the site assistants pitches but not the managers pitch
- The alarm can be heard from the reception

Your Laundry and Food Preparation Areas

- o The Laundry and dishwashing areas are accessed by a ramp with a slight incline
- The surface type leading to these areas are concrete path, non slip
- The taps in both areas are twist tops
- The washing machine is front loading, the dryer is attached to the top of the washing machine and is front loading
- The washing machine can be loaded from the floor. The dryer can be loaded from standing height
- o There is a coin operated iron
- o The iron is wall mounted
- There is an ironing board
- o The ironing board is wall mounted
- There are washing up facilities
- o The washing up facilities are indoor
- The washing up sinks have twist taps
- There is an outdoor drying area next to the second facility block

Your Recreational Areas

- o There is no recreation area on site but there is a large recreation area next to the site
- o There is no children's play area on site, but a large children's play area next to the site

Waste, Fire and Evacuation

- There is flat level access leading to the refuse area's
- o The path is tarmac and concrete
- o There is no step up or kerb
- There are no handrails leading to the refuse area's
- The height of the waste containers are 52 inches
- o There are 4 fire triangle on site
- o There is unrestricted access to firefighting equipment
- The fire assembly point is the car park next to the reception
- The assembly point surface is tarmac

Miscellaneous Information

- o There are speed bumps on the site roads
- The lighting conditions on site during hours of darkness are lights around the facility blocks and reception. There are lights on the hook up posts but generally dark away from the facilities. Pitch areas are unlit
- o The reception carpark holds 5 cars
- The overnight car park hold 5 cars
