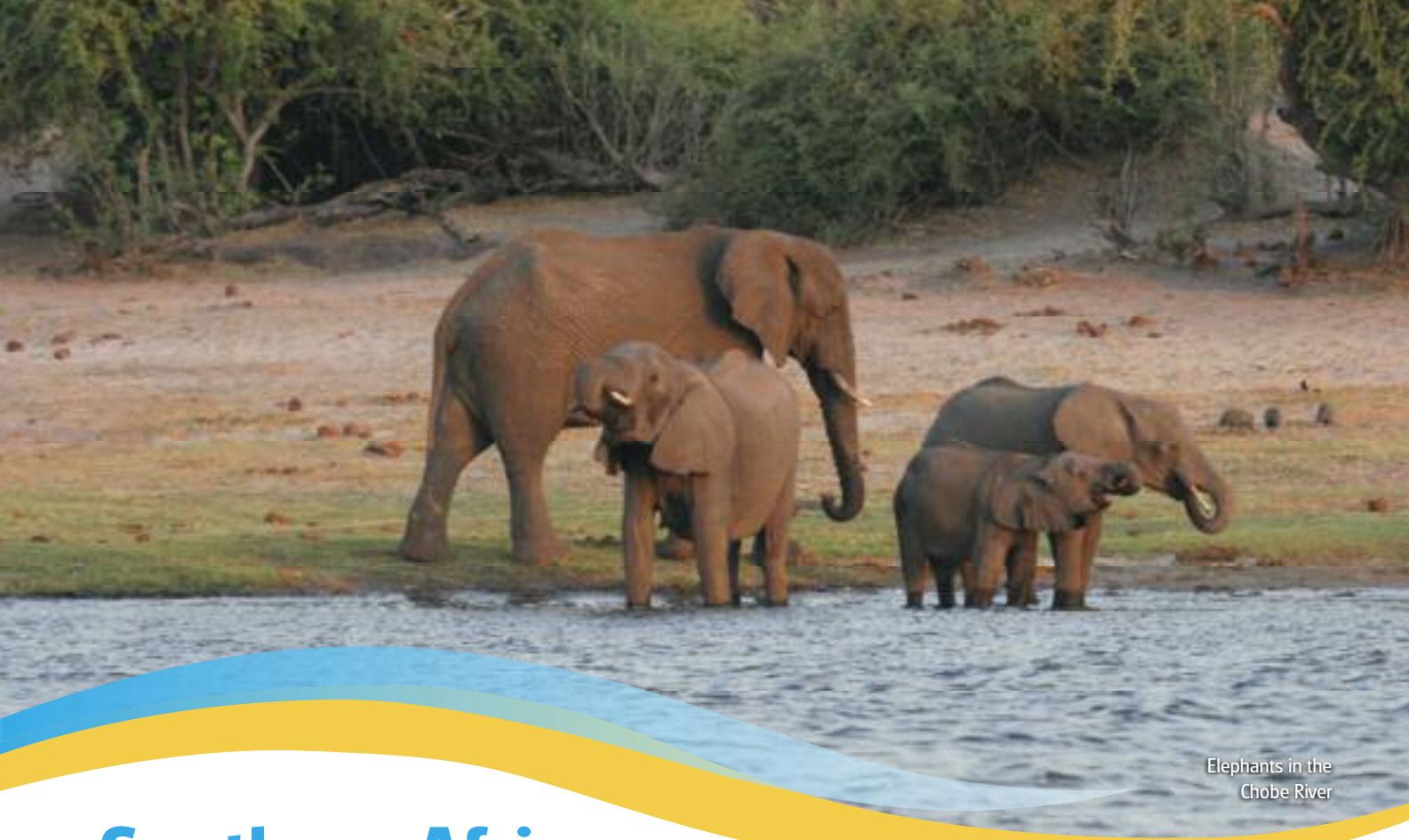

There are depots in Johannesburg and Cape Town and Windhoek. Airport transfers to and from the depot, plus luggage storage for itineraries that

depart from and return to the same depot, are part of the service. Campsite directories, a handbook for your vehicle, a thorough briefing on how the motorhome works, a map book and general information all go to build up a comprehensive information pack and start-up service provided when you collect your vehicle from the depot. Extras are available and include: GPS with charger; 220V heater; binoculars; two man tent with sleeping bags and mattresses; baby car seat for children under two years; gas barbecue. 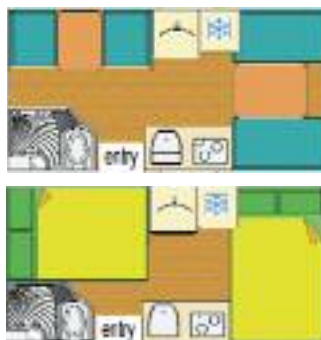
