Help us to help you

The Club's Carefree Travel Service has its own dedicated phone lines, including one at local-call rate from anywhere in the UK. We are very busy, especially in January and July and on most Mondays. Your call is very important and we always answer as soon as we can, but if this is longer than we would like please bear with us in the queueing system.

Winter Sun sites and rallies – do book early

On all Winter Sun rallies and Winter Sun campsites we strongly recommend you book the maximum and exact length of stay you require before you travel. Many sites are so popular that members who arrive early or who want to extend their stay later may end up disappointed. Some sites are so much in demand that we have to return any unsold space to the campsite before the end of the season, especially for the main holiday and festival periods. If you leave booking until later we will have to contact the site to request space and a pitch may well not be available.

On all rally sites we are also able to make pitch bookings for you outside of the rally period. If the site's pricing structure allows, this will be shown as one leg of your booking, and where discounts are applicable these will apply across your whole stay. In some cases, however, both types of booking have to be kept separate, which is normally when we have managed to negotiate a special rally price for you.

WHEN YOU BOOK – CHECKLIST OF WHAT YOU NEED

- Club membership number
- Vehicle details (make, model, dimensions, registration)
- Accurate unit dimensions – both shipping length and dimensions when pitched
- Method of payment (e.g. credit or debit card).

ONLINE BOOKINGS

- Ferry companies vary the times when they set up their timetables, so some ferry bookings are not yet available online in June, but may be through our Travel Specialists. We hope most routes to be online by the end of August.
- If a campsite is not available for booking online you will be asked to call us to make a booking.
- Please enter your vehicle and unit details accurately and take note of any campsite restrictions.
- Special requests can only be made through our Travel Specialists, and cannot be guaranteed.

PAYMENT

- Mastercard, Visa and Maestro cards are accepted. Sorry, but we can't accept Electron or American Express.
- Cheques should be made payable to "The Camping and Caravanning Club". Cheques are not accepted for non-refundable payments, which are required by some transport carriers and some other products. Please allow seven clear banking days for cheques to clear.

Book early (and for your full intended dates on site), then sit back and relax



MAKING OR EXTENDING A RALLY OR SITE BOOKING WHILE ABROAD

- To contact Carefree from abroad please use the priority Members Abroad phone number given in your travel pack.
- All bookings are subject to availability.
- Altering or extending your booking could mean moving pitches, as your pitch may already have been allocated to an advance-booked new arrival.
- If, after departure from your home, you extend the duration of your stay on a site and this takes the nightly rate into a lower price band than the original booking, then no refund will be due.

Making a new booking

- If not already on the site, contact Carefree by fax (024 7642 2010) or phone, giving your contact details abroad, or book through the website.
- If we need to contact the site and/or Rally Stewards to check availability, an answer may not be instantaneous.
- We are sorry that we are unable to make bookings less than 24 hours ahead, nor at weekends or bank holidays.
- Payment in full will be required at the time of booking and your site voucher will be faxed to you on site.
- If you are already at the site, make a booking direct with site reception. Please note that you may not be entitled to the special fees available for advanced bookings.
- At the Playa Tropicana rally please arrange your new on-site booking with the Rally Stewards.

Extending your winter sun rally booking

- All rally extensions must be made through your Rally Stewards. Check with them both availability and the best way to contact Carefree.
- A form with all the information necessary for extending your booking can be obtained from your Rally Stewards.
- If you leave your decision to extend to near the time you are due to leave the rally it may be difficult to arrange an extension through Carefree, especially at weekends. In this case you will have to book the extra nights direct with site reception at the public tariff.
- Extensions at La Manga can be made only at reception and will be at the public tariff.

Extending your Winter Sun site booking

- If your booking has more than five days left, contact Carefree and give your contact details abroad. An administration fee will be charged.
- If you have five nights or less before you are due to leave the site, book the extra nights direct with site reception.

ON SITE – ANY PROBLEMS OR DIFFICULTIES

We hope that, like the vast majority of members, you have a very happy and trouble-free stay. If you have any problem on site that cannot be resolved with the help of the Rally Stewards or the site staff, please contact Carefree Travel Service during the office hours shown on page 70. Please remember that it is a condition of booking (see pages 94-97) that we be given the opportunity to resolve any complaints while you are still on site.



To help make sure we offer all members good value for their Winter Sun holiday, we need to apply a late booking fee of £20 to cover the extra cost of administering late bookings and amendments. If extending a rally booking through the Rally Stewards on site there will be no such charge, but we will not send you an updated site voucher. We must again emphasise that extending while on site is an unreliable way to secure the stay you want. Forward planning and early booking are the best way to avoid both disappointment and extra costs – please do book your full intended dates in advance and early.

Holiday cover – motoring and personal travel insurance

If you are not taking our personal insurance, please note that providing us with proof of alternative cover is a condition of booking a pitch, tour or campsite accommodation.

With all the help to plan your holiday from the Carefree travel specialists you may think nothing could go wrong while you are away. However, even the most carefully planned holiday can be upset by an unexpected mishap, and the cost of travelling without adequate insurance can be high, not only financially but in disruption and inconvenience to your holiday.

Some travellers rely on an EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) for all their medical needs. While an EHIC will avoid the medical excess if you claim, it cannot provide all of the cover you need, such as additional accommodation and travel costs or emergency repatriation home. Nor will you necessarily be covered for every country you intend to visit.

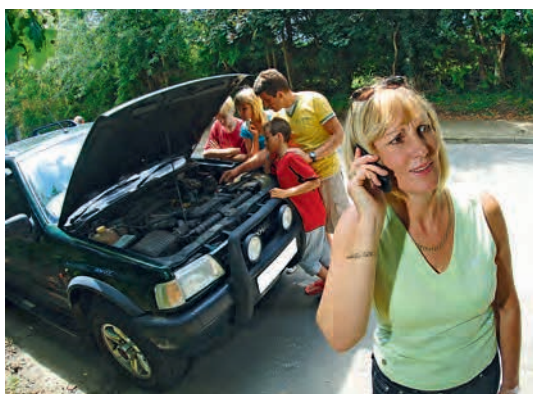

Cheryl Wilkes (left) and her husband David from Suffolk were enjoying a Winter Sun break at the Club rally at Albufeira, in Portugal, when Cheryl had a fall, fracturing a bone in her back. Luckily Cheryl and David had taken out Europ Assistance's annual Multi-trip insurance. After two weeks in a Portuguese hospital, Europ Assistance arranged for Cheryl to be repatriated to her local hospital in the UK.

According to Cheryl, the medical team that escorted her did everything possible to ensure she had a comfortable journey home. You have the right to cancel any policy of insurance within 14 days of the date of issue or receipt of the terms and conditions, whichever is later. We will refund to you any premium you have paid and will recover from you any payments we have made.

IMPORTANT – STRICT MEDICAL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

You must comply with the following conditions in order to have full protection under this policy. If You do not comply We may, at Our option, cancel the policy, refuse to deal with Your claim or reduce the amount of any claim payment. This insurance operates on the following basis:

- 1 To be covered, You must be healthy, fit to travel and to undertake Your planned Trip;
- 2 The insurance will **NOT** cover You when You are travelling against the advice of a Medical Practitioner (or would be travelling against the advice of a Medical Practitioner had You sought his/her advice);
- 3 The insurance will **NOT** cover You when You are travelling with the intention of obtaining medical treatment or consultation abroad.
- 4 The insurance will **NOT** cover You if You have any undiagnosed symptoms that require attention or investigation in the future (that is symptoms for which You are awaiting investigations/ consultations, or awaiting results of investigations, where the underlying cause has not been established).

No claim arising directly or indirectly from a Pre-existing Medical Condition affecting You will be covered unless:

- You have declared ALL Pre-existing Medical Conditions to the Medical Screening Helpline; and
- You have declared any changes in Your health or prescribed medication; and

● We have accepted that condition for insurance in writing. Each Insured Person who has a Pre-existing Medical Condition must make a Medical Health Declaration before each Period of Insurance and, if there are any changes in Your health or prescribed medication, prior to commencement of the period insurance or departing on any Trip. Failure to declare all Pre-existing Medical Conditions that are relevant to the insurance may invalidate the policy.

Based on Our assessment of the medical information supplied to the Medical Screening Helpline, the Underwriters will decide whether or not the person is suitable for insurance, if certain exclusions or restrictions should be imposed, or if cover can be offered subject to the payment of an additional premium. If cover is offered, it is subject to written confirmation from the Medical Screening Helpline.

To declare a Pre-existing Medical Condition or a change in Your state of health or prescribed medication, You should contact the Medical Screening Helpline during office hours after purchasing your insurance.

IMPORTANT LIMITATIONS – CANCELLATION, CURTAILMENT AND TRIP INTERRUPTION COVER

This policy will **NOT** cover any claims under section 6 (Cancellation, Curtailment or Trip Interruption) arising directly or indirectly from any Pre-existing Medical Condition (known to You prior to the commencement of the Period of Insurance) affecting any Close relative, travelling companion or person with whom You intend to stay whilst on Your Trip, if during the 90 days immediately prior to commencement of the period of insurance they had:

- required surgery, inpatient treatment or hospital consultations, or have been prescribed medication or required any form of treatment or prescribed medication; or
- if they were on a waiting list for, or had knowledge of the need for, surgery, inpatient treatment or investigation at any hospital or clinic at the commencement of the Period of Insurance; or
- if a terminal diagnosis had been received prior to the commencement of the Period of Insurance
