

Trailer pre journey checklist

Simply cut around the card following the dashed line and then fold along the dotted line to create a handy business card size information sheet.



Before folding, empty inner storage pockets Internal articles - Ensure secure Security locks - Remove all Wheel nut torque and tyre pressures - Check Gas cylinders - Check taps are closed at cylinder (if fitted) Fridge - set to 12V mode, check travel catch engaged (if fitted) Mains Electrics - Isolate (if fitted) Fresh water system - drain, disconnect and stow pump (if fitted) Toilet - Empty & Drain flush tank (if fitted) Check security of transit cover and luggage/bike rack	Mains and TV cables - Disconnect & stow (as required) Corner steadies - Raise Noseweight - Check on level ground & adjust as required (if fitted) Motor Mover - Ensure disengaged (if fitted) External lockers & loads - Check secured HITCH UNIT, connect tow electrics & breakaway cable (Unbraked trailers should have secondary cable or safety chain) Jockey wheel - Wind down to apply load to hitch Check unit hitched safely, including breakaway cable routing Jockey wheel - Stow & release handbrake
