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Subject: Transportation of Members

Generally speaking the use of motor vehicles for the transportation of members is a private matter between members and is outside the auspices of the Club.

There are certain circumstances however, and in particular when youth are being carried, that require rules to be followed to ensure that the Club exercises a responsibility of care.

YOUTH MEMBERS UNDER 18 MUST HAVE WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM A PARENT OR GUARDIAN BEFORE THEY CAN BE CARRIED AS PASSENGERS ON ANY JOURNEY AND IN ANY VEHICLE, UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE CLUB, AND AN 'APPLICATION TO OPERATE TRANSPORT FORM MUST BE COMPLETED AND APPROVED.

Club units cannot own vehicles in the name of the Club, the unit, or through a nominee. All vehicles must be privately owned or hired and conform to the Road Traffic Act.

Drivers

Drivers' requirements for private and self-drive hire vehicles being operated under an 'Application to Operate Transport' are as follows:

- 1. Be aged 25 years and over.
- Hold a full driving licence for more than 5 years.
- 3. Have experience of the type of **vehicle** to be driven.
- 4. Not have any outstanding motor insurance claims.
- 5. May have the following endorsements (see Appendix 1) providing that the driver has only one endorsement within a12 month period and if two endorsements that each is more than12 months apart.
- 6. Not have more than two endorsements that are current (as Appendix 1).
- 7. The applicant will fill out the appropriate form for application and must sign the application form.

They must provide a copy of their driving licence and insurance for the application to be considered.

This will be attached to the application form and kept on file. The insurance certificate must cover the vehicle being used.

<u>Insurance</u>

Insurance cover must be provided by the owner of the vehicle and must include third party cover for the intended use. The Club does not have any insurance to cover members travelling to or from any event. Under no circumstances should more people be carried than the number of seats provided and account must be taken of any equipment to be carried such that the vehicle is not overloaded or gangways blocked.

HIRED VEHICLES

Hired Vehicles - Self Drive

An 'Application to Operate Transport' form must be completed for the use of any hired vehicle. The full cost of the vehicle can be shared among the people being carried.

Hired Vehicles - with Driver

An 'Application to Operate Transport' form must be completed. All vehicles **hired** with a driver are classed as being for hire and reward and can therefore be paid for by other methods other than on a 'sharing of cost between those carried' basis.

PRIVATE VEHICLES

Private Vehicles up to and including 8 Seats Plus the Driver

All private vehicles must be equipped to comply with the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986 as amended.

All motor insurance policies allow the owner to 'car share' i.e. for passengers to share the fuel costs for a journey.

The journey should not be made for the sole benefit of the passengers, it must be a journey which the driver was going to make himself.

While the journey must not be advertised publicly in advance, notice within the Club unit giving details of the journey is acceptable.

For members over 18 the use of such vehicles and the carrying of passengers is a private matter between the members and does not involve the Club.

Private Vehicles - 9 Seats and up to and including 16 Seats Plus the Driver

These vehicles are classed as mini buses and as such require additional equipment such as fire extinguishers and first aid kits to comply with the Road Vehicle (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986. Otherwise they can be used in the same way as a smaller private vehicle but the insurance policy must cover the number of seats fitted. If the vehicle is to be taken abroad then the regulations for the countries to be visited must be checked.

Vehicles with 17 or more seats require a driver with a PSV licence and a tacograph fitted to the vehicle. It is unlikely that such vehicles would be privately owned and insured and vehicles of this capacity should be hired with a driver.
