As the owner of a Certificated Site, you're already providing a unique camping opportunity for Club members, but if you also have land that's currently unused, it could be the perfect setting for Social Camping events.



Social Camping is at the heart of our Club

The Club's District Associations, Regions and Special Interest Sections organise hundreds of Meets and Temporary Holiday Sites across the country and throughout the year. They're covered by our exemptions, so there'd be no planning permission or admin fees involved in hosting them.

Events vary in size and duration, depending on available space and the arrangements you make with the coordinator, who will be in charge of each one.

Hosts and coordinators agree the price for hosting a Meet or THS, either a fixed amount or calculated per attending unit. You keep all the fees you charge.



Meets

Duration: One to five nights, usually across a weekend

Attendees: Members only

Max units: Determined in advance based on space available

Facilities requirements: Whilst no facilities are required, we would expect drinking water to be available

Temporary Holiday Sites (THS)

Duration: Six to 28 nights

Attendees: Members (non-members can stay in

member's unit as guests)

Max units: Determined in advance based on space

available

Facilities requirements: Chemical disposal point and associated rinsing water tap for toilet cassettes, drinking water tap and dry waste disposal point

(can be on your CS)
