About Charmouth

Charmouth Camping and Caravanning is an idyllic campsite based on the Dorset/Devon border, approximately 3 miles from Charmouth and Lyme Regis.

The site is gradually sloping with a variety of pitches ranging from grass only to super serviced. Super fast Wi-Fi is offered free of charge across the site.



Your Arrival on Site

The nearest train station is 4 miles from site. The nearest bus stop is approx. 1 mile for site.

There are two brown signs off the A35, one large site sign on entrance.

The main entrance barrier is open all day and shuts automatically 11pm and reopens at 7am. The secondary entrance barrier (further down the lane) is manually opened whilst there are staff working. Approximately 8:30am - 4:30pm.

Overnight parking is available between the two entrances along Scotts Lane.

The overnight car park can hold at least six cars.

New arrivals should pull up to reception. It is clearly sign posted where to park. The surface is tarmac and its reasonably level.

There are steps and a ramp which lead into reception.

There are no dedicated disabled parking bays. A bench is situated immediately outside reception.





Your Check In

The reception is clearly signed for arrivals.

There are two steps up to the reception door; alternatively, a ramp is provided.

There is a 25mm high threshold to cross to enter the reception.

There is adequate space in reception for a wheelchair to turn around.

Dogs are not allowed in the reception/shop area - with the exception of guide/assistance dogs.



Your Pitch

Camping pitches are either grass or gravel.

Some gravel hard standings have to be accessed across grass areas, some are accessible directly from the internal site roads.

Our park is generally well lit. It is, advisable, however to bring a torch and just in case you forget yours, we do have them for sale in our on-site shop.



Travelling Around Site

The holiday park is situated on a slope, with 50% of access roads either going up or down the slope.

The roads are mainly tarmac with some compacted hardcore.

At night the entrance to the holiday park is controlled by a locked barrier between 2300hrs and 0700hrs.

Between these times access is via the overnight parking area. The parking area is compacted gravel.

Pedestrian access to the site from the late night parking area is via a 1.2m wide path through a 1.2 m wide wooden gate.



There is a 10m paving stone path leading to the main tarmac internal site roads.



The Facility Block

There are three shower blocks, block A has a 100mm step into men's and women's, however once you're in there, the toilets and showers have level access.

One shower room provides full ablution facilities suitable for the partially disabled and this has ramp access.

Block B has a fully accessible shower/wash/toilet facilities, access controlled by a RADAR key, (If you do not have a RADAR key, we have spare keys at reception available for a refundable deposit, please ask on arrival).

Block C can be found by the super serviced pitches and has steps leading up to the facilities block so does not have wheelchair access. However, there is an accessible room which has extra room and handrails.



The Accessible Facilities

There is a flat level concrete slab path leading to the accessible facility.

There is flat level access into the accessible facility.

There are handrails next to the toilet.

There is a regular size flush handle.

There is transfer space to the left of the toilet.

There is a hand dryer located in the room.

There is a low-level mirror above the sink that does not extend to full height.

The shower has a number of handrails.



The shower is open access, not a cubicle.

The shower head is height adjustable.

The floor is nonslip.

There is a hair dryer.

There is an emergency cord next to the toilet and in the shower. Both can be reached from the floor.

The accessible room can be accessed with a RADAR key.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

Washing Up Areas:

There are 3 washing up areas onsite, the approach path is concrete to the main two washing up areas and gravel to the third. All three have hot and cold water.

Laundry:

The washing machines and tumble dryers are front loading and can be reached from the floor. There is also a wall mounted iron and ironing board.



Recreational Areas

There is an indoor recreation area.

There is a slight ramp leading to this area.

There are no steps leading to the indoor recreational area.

There is a variety of seating available such as sofas and freestanding chairs.

There is an outdoor children play area.

This is accessible over grass with no designated path.

There are several seating areas overlooking the play area.



The play area has a bark surface with raise edges surrounding it to keep the bark in place.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is a slight slope leading up to the refuse areas.

There are no steps or curbs restricting access to the refuse areas.

All bins on site are full height industrial 1100L units.

There is a fire triangle located at all water points which has unrestricted accessed over grass.

All fire extinguishers can be accessed over grass or on tarmac depending on the position.

Fire assembly points are located at both the site entrances and one up in the Camping Field.
