Your Arrival on Site

- Train station 4 miles from site. Bus stop is approx. 500m
- One small sign at the top of the lane, one large site sign in the car park
- There are large gates at the entrance to the site which are kept closed for site security
- One keypad operated barrier that is automatic on exit. Manual barrier locked between 11pm and 7am
- Overnight parking is available inside the main site gate
- Approach is tarmac leading to loose gravel
- The visitors parking doubles as the overnight which is 10m from the main gate
- New arrivals should pull up to the reception parking bay. The surface is gravel and it's reasonably level
- No steps and a reasonably level pathway
- Potted plants along the path

Your Check in

- The reception is clearly signed for arrivals
- Opening hours are 9am-10:30am then 4pm-6pm
- For out of hours emergencies, site number is listed on reception
- Approach to reception is level concrete slabs
- Slight lip on the door
- Good clear floor space in reception
- There is a low level reception counter, clipboards are available

Your Pitch

- Cars can be parked next to most pitches on site
- Loose, smaller gravel on hardstanding's.
- Many level hardstanding are close to the site road
- o Grass pitches are close to the road but not adjacent

• There are no facilities on this site
