Your Arrival on Site

The nearest train station is 7.5 miles from site. The nearest bus stop is approx. 1.25 miles from site.

There are two brown signs off the A123, one large site sign on entrance.

There is one keypad operated barrier that is automatic on exit. It's locked between 11pm and 7am.

The overnight parking is available just outside the main site gate next to reception.

The main reception car park can hold at least seven cars.

The overnight car park can hold at least seven cars.

There is a tarmac surface to site leading to gravel in the car park.

The visitors parking doubles as the overnight parking which is next to the main gate.

New arrivals should pull up to reception. The surface is tarmac and is level.

There are no designated spaces but plenty of spaces a short, level distance from the reception.

There is no handrail attached to the reception wall but there is a handrail leading up to reception on the veranda.

There are 3 steps one side but a ramp on the other side of the veranda leading to reception.

There are no potted plants along the path.



Your Check In

The reception is clearly signed for arrivals.

Opening hours are 9am-10:30am then 4pm-6pm.

There is a bell located on the reception door which is connected to an on duty team member.

There are level concrete slabs leading to reception.

There is a slight lip on the door.

There is good clear floor space in reception.

There is a low-level reception counter is present, and clipboards are available.



Your Pitch

Cars can be parked next to most pitches on site.

There are five pitches close to the accessible room. There is loose, large gravel on two and compact smaller gravel on three.

Many level hardstanding and grass pitches are close to the site road.

Campers can park on their pitch. There is a limit of 1 car per pitch. Additional vehicles can park in the visitor parking, space permitting.



Travelling Around Site

There are speed bump along the main site road.

At night there is high level lighting on the outside of all blocks and the rest of the site is dimly lit by hook-up bollards.



The Facility Block

There is a clear, well-maintained path leading to the facilities.

There are no steps to the rear of the facility block, but level from the front.

There is a gentle ramp leading into the blocks on one side.

There are threshold steps into the ladies and gents, family and accessible room.

There is one semi-ambulant cubicle in both men's and ladies.

All sinks have push button taps throughout.

There are stools with rubber feet in all showers.

The showers are operated by a push button in the gents, ladies and in the family room.

There are no steps into the showers, these are all mini wet rooms.

The facility block has high level, wall mounted lights.



The Accessible Facilities

There is a flat concrete flag stone path leading to the accessible facility.

There are no handrails leading to the accessible facility.

There is a ramp into the accessible facility.

There are handrails next to the toilet.

There is a large size flush handle.

There is no transfer space to the left of the toilet.

The wash basin can be reached from the toilet.

The washbasin has larger than normal lever top taps.

There is a hand dryer located in the room.

There is a low-level mirror above the sink that does not extend to full height.

The shower has a number of handrails.

The shower has a large lever.

The shower is open access, not a cubicle.

The shower head is height adjustable.

The floor is nonslip.

There is a hairdryer.

There is an emergency chord next to the toilet and in the shower. Both can be reached from the floor.

The emergency alarm can be heard from both staff pitches and also reception.

The accessible room can be accessed with a RADAR key.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

The laundry and food preparation areas both have level access.

The approach path is flag stones.

The taps are push button top.

The washing machine is front loading and can be reached from the floor.

The tumble dryers are top loading and can be reached from the floor.
There is a wall mounted iron.

There is no freestanding iron.

There are indoor washing up facilities available.

All washing up sinks have push button top taps.

There is an outdoor drying area with a rota dryer.

There is no low-level sink in the indoor washing up area.



Recreational Areas

There is no indoor recreation area.

There is an outdoor children's play area.

This is accessible over grass with no designated path.

There is a single bench overlooking the play area.

The play area has a rubber safety surface with raised edges surrounding it.

This entire area is not fenced in.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is a short, steep concrete ramp leading up to all refuse areas.

There are no steps or kerbs restricting access to the refuse areas.

There is a waist high fence either side of the entrance ramp which may be used as a handrail and a fence surrounding the compound.

All bins on site are full height industrial 1100L units.

There is a ring bell located at all water points which has unrestricted access over grass.

The firefighting equipment is accessed over grass.

The assembly points are located in the main car park which is loose gravel and the other is next to the water point in the lower camping field which is grass.

Campers are briefed about the assembly point on arrival, there are clear signs.
