

## **Access Statement – Nairn**

### **Your Point of Contact**

### **Your Arrival on Site**

- Train station 3 miles from site, bus stops 200 yards from site entrance
- A9: From Inverness one brown & white sign 800yds before turning to site plus 1 sign at right turn to site. From Nairn one brown & white sign at left turn to site. Also 1 brown & white sign at site entrance. Club site signs: Two at turning off A96 plus 1 at site entrance
- Only one manual barrier on site (in & out) locked from 11.00pm to 7.00am
- Out of hours information posted on reception/recreation room door
- Approach road is tarmac up to barrier, mixture of tarmac and compacted gravel on site
- Visitor parking doubles as overnight parking, situated opposite reception
- New arrivals should stop on entrance road at sign 'ARRIVALS PLEASE STOP HERE' and white lines on road. Exit vehicle onto level tarmac
- No designated accessible parking, car park has level gravel surface approx 20-30m from reception
- There are no handrails
- There are no steps or inclines leading to reception
- There is a kerb (painted white) from entrance road, then a paved path to reception with half barrels of potted plants along it

### **Your Check in**

- Reception is clearly signed for arrivals
- Opening hours are: early & late in season when quiet: 9.00 to 10.00am & 4.00 to 5.00pm
- Busy periods: 9.00 to 10.30am & 4.00 to 5.30pm
- For out of hours there will be a notice on the recreation/reception room door with instructions on how to contact a team member out of hours
- Access leading to reception is over level concrete slabs
- Very slight lip on doorway to recreation room
- Good clear floor space in reception
- Main reception is located off recreation room

### **Your Pitch**

- All pitches have space for a car next to the unit
- No hardstanding pitches on this site
- Several pitches of varying sizes are close to the facility block

### **Your Facilities**

- Yes –Path is gravel leading to crazy paving to main facilities, gravel to CDP point, gravel and concrete slabs to pot wash area
- There are no steps
- Wooden ramp leading from crazy paving to ladies & gents facilities
- Level access from platform at top of ramp
- There is no semi-ambulant cubicle on site
- All taps are screw top
- Shower stools in all showers
- All showers are dial operated
- Small step, approx. 75mm into shower tray
- Shower block is lit by wall mounted sensor lights at night
- There is a fixed grab handle in each shower and we are in the process of adapting one toilet each in the ladies & gents facilities to incorporate one fixed and one drop down handle

### **Your Accessible Facilities**

- There are no accessible facilities on site

### **Your Laundry and Food Preparation Areas** Do these areas have good level access?

- No food preparation area, only a pot wash
- There is a ramp to the laundry and level access to the pot wash area
- Gravel and grass leading to the Laundry, gravel and concrete slabs leading to the pot wash area
- All taps are screw top taps
- Both washing machines are top loading
- They cannot be loaded from the floor
- Both tumble driers are front loading
- They are floor level
- There is a wall mounted iron
- The ironing board is free standing and is folded away when not in use
- There are outdoor but undercover washing up facilities
- All taps are screw top taps
- There is an outdoor drying area to the rear of the laundry with one carousel drier
- Drying area is gravel, approach is along a path of concrete slabs

### **Your Recreational Areas**

- There is an indoor recreation area
- Access is level
- There are no steps
- There is seating available
- White plastic tables, with white plastic chairs plus 3 upholstered lounge chairs in front of the TV
- There is an outside children's play area
- There is flat level access leading to it over grass
- There are three benches near the play area
- The surface is grass with bark under the play equipment
- There is no raised edge

### **Waste, Fire and Evacuation**

- There is flat level access to the refuse area
- The path is a mixture of grass, gravel and concrete slaps
- There is no step up or kerb
- There are no handrails
- The waste containers are 1200mm high
- There is a fire triangle at all fire points
- There is unrestricted access to firefighting equipment
- Assembly Point 1 is in the car park, Assembly Point 2 is next to our jumbo grass only pitch
- Assembly Point 1 is gravel and Assembly Point 2 is grass

### **Miscellaneous Information**

- There are 2 speed bumps on the entrance road before the barrier, there are none beyond the barrier
- All electric bollards have low level dusk to dawn sensor downlights, the water points each have one high dusk to dawn sensor light and there are wall mounted dusk to dawn sensor lights at the facilities. The laundry and CDP point each has a movement sensor light
- Reception car park holds approx. 18-20 cars
- Reception car park is also overnight car park and can hold approx. 18-20 cars
