Take a stroll southward into Beadnell, or northward to Seahouses, where you can hop on a boat to the beautiful Farne Islands – a cluster of islands famously labelled by iconic broadcaster Sir David Attenborough as his favourite place in the UK to see nature. Keep an eye out for the colony of grey seals lazing on the shores and the puffins perched on craggy cliffs.

Don't forget to bring your bike too, as both the Coast and Castles and National Cycle Routes pass the entrance to the campsite.



Your Arrival on Site

The earliest arrival time on site is strictly 1pm. Approach surface is tarmac directly off the B1340 just outside of Beadnell Village towards Seahouses.

Arrival surface is a large U shaped area , part tarmac and part gravelled with a ' please wait here' sign and painted road line opposite the Reception office.

There is an automatic barrier with key pad number code. There are spaces for ' Visitor Parking' available on site.

There is no designated accessible parking.

There is a bus stop 500m from site on the Haven which is opposite the village shop. These bus stops are for Alnwick (or as far as Newcastle) in the south and Berwick upon Tweed in the north.

There is a railway station at Chathill 5 miles from the site.



Your Check In

The reception block is the building on the right as you drive in just before the barrier. The reception is clearly signed.

Access to Reception is via a slight ramp.

There is a wide doorway with a shallow ridge at the bottom and the door opens inwards. The floor space is free from clutter and there is turning for wheelchairs.

Reception opening times will be displayed on the notice board by the door.

The latest assisted pitching is 8PM.

Staff are not on duty after 8.00pm but an emergency telephone number is provided for blue light emergencies after this time. This phone number can be found printed on your Site Welcome leaflet.

Details of local hospitals, doctors, dentists and vets can be found on the noticeboard outside reception and amenity entrance.

Your Pitch

Hardstanding pitches are gravel.

Most pitches are flat.

There are no pitches directly next to the accessible room.

Campers can park on or next to their pitch. There is a limit of 1 car per pitch.

We sadly have no sea views from any pitch.



Travelling Around Site

All site roads are tarmac. There is a speed limit around the site of 5mph. There are various speed bumps around the site.

Some of our grass pitches are accessed over grass, maximum distance approx. 200m.

All the electrical bollards are lit up at night. A torch is recommended when walking around the site at night.



The Facility Block

The area leading to the facilities block is paved. There are no steps.

There are two sinks in the outside dishwash 880mm high, with lever taps and found in the inside at 880mm high, the taps are push button type.

The sinks in the facilities block have push button taps.

The showers are push button. There are no steps in the showers. There are removable stools for most shower cubicles.

The facility block and access are well lit at night.

There is only easy access room attached to the main facilities block for wheelchairs.

Assistance dogs are permitted in the facility block.

There is no parent and child room on site.

The Accessible Facilities

There is a ramp to access the accessible facilities which is located on the side of the main facility block, having its own door opening directly on to the pathway. There are handrails leading to the facility.

The door has a 100mm opening width and opens outwards. This facility needs a radar key to open and is open to all customers 10.30am to 12.00 noon for toilet use during the main facility block cleaning times. There is a pull handle on the door.

The taps are lever type

The shower is open access, flat we room style with no tray to set into. The shower has two grab rails and a pull down seat capable of taking a weight of 95kg. It is temperature controllable, and the shower head is height adjustable.

The toilet has drop down handrails on one side. The toilet has a larger flush handle. There is transfer space both sides of the toilet when handrail is lifted.

The floor is non-slip.

There is an emergency cord by the toilet that can be reached from the floor and one by the shower. The alarm can be heard from the staff pitches and Reception.

Assistance dogs are permitted in the facility block.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

The laundry is located at the rear of the reception building and has a 140mm step to access it. There are no handrails leading to the laundry area. There is no wheelchair turning room in the laundry. The door to the Laundry opens inwards.

The taps are screw type.

There is one sink 870mm high.

There are two washing machine and tumble dryers. They are stacked and both are front loading.

There is an iron and ironing board.



Recreational Areas

There is no indoor Recreational Area.

There is an outdoor play area. This is situated at the top end of the site.

There are two wooden benches available in the play area.

Play area surface is rubber and is surrounded by glass. There are four swings, a slide and a climbing frame.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is flat, level access leading to the refuse area, which is situated at the site entrance. The road is tarmac. There are no hand rails.

The Waste Containers are 1190mm high with lift up lids.

There is flat level access to all water taps.

There is flat level access to all waste points.

The site has a CDP. There is flat level access which is situated on the left of the main door to the facility block, It is in a brick cupboard ., this is 450mm high ledge and has a sensor light if needed at night.

There are fire triangles on site. There is unrestricted access to the firefighting equipment.

Fire assembly area main entrance and grass area near pitch 119 and are marked on the Site Welcome Leaflet.
