Your Arrival on Site

The nearest train station is 4.5 miles from the site. The nearest bus stop is 400 yards to the right of site near the church.

There are council brown signs at the end of roads, and a Camping and Caravanning Club sign at top of drive.

There is a coded barrier, gates are locked to vehicles between 11pm and 7am.

The approach road is tarmac.

When site barriers are locked overnight, please use car park near reception.

There is no designated accessible parking.

The reception car park will hold 13 cars.

On arrival, please pull over to the left of the barrier; the tarmac road has a slight incline.

There are no steps or steep inclines.



Your Check In

The reception is clearly signed.

The reception opening hours are 9:00am – 10:30am and 16.00pm – 18.00pm.

Please ring the doorbell out of hours.

There is level access leading to reception.

There are no specific access issues.

The floor is clear from clutter.



Your Pitch

One car per pitch can be parked next to units.

There are a number of hardstanding pitches located near the accessible facility.

The hardstanding pitches are gravel.

There are a number of level pitches that are close to facility blocks.



Travelling Around Site

There are speed bumps on site.

The site is dark around pitches, but reception and facilities are well lit.

The Facility Block

There is a clear, well-maintained path leading to the facilities.

There are no steps or ramps leading to the facility block.

There is level access into the facility block.

There is no semi-ambulant cubicle.

There are a mixture of screw top and push button taps throughout.

There are seats within the shower.

The showers are a mixture of dial and push button operated.

Showers have level access.

The facility block is lit at night.



The Accessible Facilities

There is a flat level path leading to the accessible facility.

There are no handrails leading to the accessible facility.

There is flat level access into the accessible facility.

The toilet has handrails.

The toilet has a large flush handle.

The washbasin can be reached from the toilet.

The taps are lever topped.

There is a hand dryer.

There is no full-length mirror.

The shower has handrails.

The shower is dial operated.

The shower head is height adjustable.

The floor is non-slip.

There is no hairdryer.

There is an emergency cord that can be reached from the floor.

The alarm can be heard from the staff pitches but not reception.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

All these areas have good level access.

Surfaces are anti slip.

Washing machines are front loading.

At least one washing machine can be loaded from the floor.

The tumble drier is a stack and can be loaded above the washing machine (and not from the floor).

There is a wall mounted iron.

There is a wall mounted ironing board.

There is screw top taps.

There is an outdoor drying area.



Recreational Areas

There is an indoor recreational area.

Access is level.

A number of chairs are available.

There is an outdoor children's play area.

Access to it is flat and level.

There is no seating available near the play area.

The surface of the play area is rubber.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is flat level access leading to the refuse area.

The path is tarmac.

There is no step or kerb.

There are no handrails leading to the compound.

There are fire triangles on site at waterpoints

There is unrestricted access to all firefighting equipment at waterpoints.

The assembly point is next to reception and near exit barrier.

The assembly point surface is tarmac and grass.
