About Bowness on Windermere

The site is close to the town of Bowness and the edge of lake Windermere. Access is available to the lake via a pedestrian gate.

The site is mostly flat and surrounded by trees.

There are 24 Super Service pitches which have fresh & waste water, TV socket and electric, 48 Hard standing pitches all with electric and 1 grass with electric

Mobile phone signal is generally good across the site.

There is no public phone on site.

Television signal is variable due to the trees surrounding the site. A signal booster is recommended.

The site has the standard club WI-FI available across the site.



Your Arrival on Site

The nearest train station is approx. 1.7 miles from site. The nearest bus stop is approx. ¼ mile from site.

There are signs from the A592 to the site and a Club Sign at the entrance.

The site barrier is open between 7am and 11pm.

Instructions regarding arriving out of hours can be found on notice at reception.

There is no overnight parking available. Pedestrian access only.

There is a reception car park with 2 spaces.

There is a dedicated accessible parking space next to reception.

New arrivals should pull up to the STOP line near the entrance barrier. The surface is level tarmac.

There are handrails at reception, both up the 3 steps and the accessible ramp.



Your Check In

The reception is clearly signed for arrivals.

The reception is open from 9:00am – 10:30am and then 1:00pm – 6:00pm.

There is a shop selling essentials in reception.

Out of hours instructions are in the site information leaflet and displayed at reception.

There are 3 steps into the reception area.

There is an accessible ramp, and the office is spacious.

The office floor space is free from clutter.



Your Pitch

Cars must be parked on the hardstanding at the front of the unit, or on the grass to the right.

Due to restrictions on this site, no extra cars are allowed on any pitch at any time.

There are some pitches close to the facilities all of which are hardstanding.

The hardstanding surface is loose gravel. All the pitches are relatively level.



Travelling Around Site

At night there is lighting on the outside of the reception and facility block and the rest of the site is dimly lit by hook up bollards.

There are 2 benches next to the facility block.



The Facility Block

There is a tarmac surface leading to the facilities.

There are no steps leading to the facilities.

There is no ramp to the facility block however, the surface is level.

There is level surface to the family and accessible room.

There is one semi-ambulant shower cubicle in each of the Ladies and Gents.

All taps are push button.

There are fixed folding stools in all showers.

The showers are operated by push button and a temperature dial.

There are no steps into the shower area.

The facility block is lit at night.



The Accessible Facilities

There is a flat level path leading to the facility.

There is a handrail on the accessible facility door.

There is flat level access into the accessible facility.

There are handrails next to the toilet.

There is an outsized flush handle.

There is transfer space at both sides of the toilet.

The washbasin has lever taps.

There is a hand dryer located in the room.

There are two low-level mirrors that do not extend to full height.

There are 2 showers, one sitting and one standing.

The showers are push/dial operated.

The showers are open access.

The sitting shower head is height adjustable.

The floor is non-slip.

There is a hairdryer.

There is an emergency cord next to the toilet and next to the standing shower.

Both emergency cords can be reached from the floor.

The emergency alarm can be heard from both staff pitches and in reception.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

There is a flat level entry into the laundry.

The approach path is tarmac.

The taps are push button.

The washing machine is front loading.

The washing machine can be loaded from the floor.

The tumble dryer is front loading.

The tumble dryer can be loaded from the floor.

There is a wall mounted iron.

There is a freestanding ironing board.

There are outdoor washing up facilities.

The washing up sinks have push button taps.

There are no food preparation areas.



Recreational Areas

There are no recreation areas on site.

There is no play area on this site.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is flat level access to the refuse area.

The refuse area is set upon a concrete slab.

There are no steps or kerbs restricting access to the refuse area.

There are no handrails to the refuse area.

All bins on site are full height industrial 1100 litre units. Approx. 1.2m high.

There is a fire triangle located at all water points.

The firefighting equipment is readily accessible.
