## About California Cross

The site is located just 2 miles off the A38, approximately 4 miles from Modbury, 8 miles from Kingsbridge and 16 miles from Plymouth.

We are also located just 13 miles from the beautiful spots of Salcombe and 12 miles from Hope Cove. Please note that there is no public transport to or from site.

The site has flat hardstanding gravel pitches and a mixture of different grass pitch types most of which are on some form of slope. Ramps and levellers are recommended. The site is surrounded by trees and hedging but once on site it is generally open.

The site offers a selection of different pitch types for tents, touring caravans, motorhomes & campervans of varying size.

Mobile reception is generally OK, with 4G usually not an issue depending on the network provider.

There is no payphone on site nor near to site.

The television signal is generally OK but can sometimes wander in and out. A booster or other viewing device is recommended.

The site offers club Wi-Fi for general internet use, but this will not accommodate streaming services.



## Your Arrival on Site

The nearest train station is 7 miles from site. The nearest bus stop is 3.5 miles from site in Modbury.

There are 3 brown signs after leaving A38, 1 roundabout and one large sign at site entrance.

After entering the site there is a barrier requiring a key code, available on check in. Exit is via an automatic barrier. Both barriers operate from 7am to 11pm.

There is no overnight parking available after 11pm.

The approach road is tarmac, it's a narrow road with passing places, especially the last mile.

There is no vehicle access once barrier is locked.

New arrivals should park outside of reception at the entrance barrier; the surface is tarmac.

There is no designated accessible parking.

There is no reception car park or overnight parking available.

There are no handrails to reception.

There are no steps or incline.

There is a small step into reception.

### Your Check In

The reception is clearly signed.

Reception hours are 9am – 10:30am & 4pm – 6pm.

If the reception is closed, please follow instructions displayed on door.

There is a small lip over the door.

There are no access issues when entering reception.

The floor space is limited but is free from clutter.



### Your Pitch

All pitches have parking adjacent.

There are hardstanding pitches near the facility block.

The hardstanding pitches have a gravel surface.

There are 2 level grass pitches near the facility block.



### Travelling Around Site

There are no speed bumps.

There is low level lighting around the toilet blocks and reception and also some of the hook-up bollards around the site.



### The Facility Block

There is a paved path leading to the block.

There are steps at one access point.

There are slight inclines to the block on two access points.

There is a large step into the ladies and gents.

There are no semi-ambulant cubicles.

All taps are screw top.

Plastic stools are available in the showers.

The showers are dial operated.

Shower has a step down into tray.

The facility block is lit by wall mounted lights controlled by light sensors.



## The Accessible Facilities

The accessible facility is situated at the rear of the block and is accessed by a slight incline at the front of the block. The path surrounding the block is paving slabs.

There are no handrails.

The access is level.

The toilet has one fixed handrail and one pull down rail.

The flush has a large handle flush lever.

There is a large area to the right of the toilet and a small gap to the left.

The wash basin cannot be reached from the toilet.

The washbasin taps are lever tops.

There is no hand dryer.

There is a small mirror above the washbasin.

The shower has handrails.

The shower is operated by a dial.

The shower is open access.

The showerhead is adjustable.

The shower floor is nonslip, the other area is tiled.

There is no hair dryer.

There is an emergency pull cord.

The emergency pull cord can be reached from the floor and is tested weekly.

The alarm cannot be heard from the staff pitches or reception.

There are paper hand towels available.



### Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

There is level access.

The path is paving slabs.

The taps are screw top.

The washing machine is front loading.

The washing machine can be loaded from the floor.

The tumble dryer is front loading.

There is a wall mounted iron.

There is a wall mounted ironing board.

The washing up facilities are indoors.

The taps are screw top.

There are 2 rotary dryers available in a compound.



### Recreational Areas

There is no indoor recreation area.

There is a small children's play area.

The access is across sloping grass.

There is a wooden bench adjacent to the play area.

The surface is bark with a wooden surround.



### Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

The waste area is accessed by a flat tarmac road.

There are no handrails.

The waste containers are approx. 1.2 metres high.

There are 3 fire bells on site, one on each water point and one adjacent to pitch 9.

The firefighting equipment is accessed over grass.

There are 2 assembly points one on the tarmac road by the site exit, the other on a grass area adjacent to the play area.
