About Chichester

Ideally situated for visiting, Portsmouth, Chichester, Emsworth and other places, within walking distance of the coast. Heading inland you have the South Downs and many pretty towns and villages.

The camping is generally flat and open; a few pitches offer shade.

The site offers Grass with electric pitches and Hardstanding with electric. Grass only for Backpacker/small tents.

Mobile phone signal is average.

There is not a public phone on site.

Television signal works better with a booster.

The site offers Wi-Fi.



Your Arrival on Site

The nearest train station is 0.5 mile from site. The nearest bus stop is approx. 150m from site.

There are no road signs showing the direction of the site. There is a site sign on the entrance.

On arrival there is one keypad operated barrier that is automatic on exit.

The gates are locked between 11pm and 7am.

Pre-arranged emergency late arrivals, out of hours should, follow the instructions given by staff and contained in the envelope left out at reception.

The approach road has a shingle surface.

There is no overnight, reception or visitors parking. Pedestrian access only.

New arrivals should pull up to the 'New Arrival Stop Here' sign before reception. The surface is shingle and level.

There is no designated accessible parking.

There are no handrails to reception.

There are no steps but there is a gentle incline.

There are potted plants around reception and facility block.



Your Check In

The reception is clearly signed for arrivals.

Opening hours are 9am – 10:30am then 4pm – 6pm.

Out of hours people should read signage at reception regarding site emergency phone number.

There is a slight incline with paving slabs.

There is a slight lip on the door.

There is good clear floor space in reception.

There is no low-level reception counter but clipboards are available.



Your Pitch

Cars can be pitched next to most pitches on site.

There are hardstanding pitches close to the accessible facilities.

Hardstanding pitches are pea gravel.

There are level pitches close to the facilities.

There are level hardstanding pitches close to the site road.



Travelling Around Site

There are no speed bumps on site.

The facility block and reception have exterior lighting and two security lights one at reception and the other at bin compound.

The pitch areas are unlit.



The Facility Block

There is a clear well-maintained path leading to the facilities.

There is one step to the rear of the facility block near the showers.

There is a gentle ramp leading to the facilities.

There is a small step up into the ladies and gents, slight lip on the door to showers, accessible and dishwashing/laundry.

There are no semi ambulant cubicles in the main block.

Ladies, gent's, showers, dishwashing, and laundry have screw taps.

There are stools in the ladies and gents' showers, weighted to 18 stone 120kg.

The showers are operated in the gents and ladies by push button.

There are no steps into the showers.

The facility block has wall mounted external lights.



The Accessible Facilities

There is a slight ramp and then level concrete slabs to the accessible facility, this a combined family room.

There are no handrails leading to the accessible facility.

There is flat level access to the accessible facility.

The toilet has handrails.

The toilet has a push button flush.

There is transfer space to the left of the toilet.

The washbasin cannot be reached from the toilet.

The taps are lever top.

There is a hand dryer located in the room.

There is a full-length mirror on the wall and a low level mirror over the wash basin.

The shower has handrails.

The shower is dial operated.

The shower is open access not a cubicle.

The shower head is height adjustable.

The floor is nonslip.

There is no hair dryer.

There is an emergency cord next to the toilet and in the shower.

Both cords can be reached from the floor.

The alarm cannot be heard from the staff pitches.

The alarm can be heard from reception.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

The laundry has good level access. There is no food preparation area on site.

The approach path is concrete slabs.

The taps are screw top.

The washing machine is front loading.

The washing machine can be loaded from the floor.

The tumble drier is front loading.

The tumble drier is above the washing machine.

There is no iron.

There are 2 washing up sinks.

The washing up sinks are indoors.

All washing up sinks have screw taps.

There is no outdoor drying area.

There are no low-level sinks.



Recreational Areas

There is no indoor recreational area.

There is no outdoor children's play area.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is level access to the refuse area.

The path is gravel.

There is no step up or kerb.

There are no handrails leading to the compound.

All bins on site are full height industrial 1100L units at 1.3m high.

There are fire triangles at the fire points.

Two fire points are accessed across grass and the remaining on gravel surfaces.

Assembly point 1 is located at site entrance and assembly point 2 is situated at the rear of site.

Assembly point 1 is gravel and assembly point 2 is grass.

Fire assembly point details are in the site leaflet.
