About Chipping Norton

A great campsite for exploring the pretty Cotswolds towns and their attractions.

Amid the honey-coloured villages of the Cotswolds is where you'll find the Club's charming Chipping Norton campsite. Tucked away off the beaten track, this campsite offers a mix of level and sloping pitches, surrounded by trees and dry stone walls.



It would be a shame not to venture off site and explore the beauty of the Cotswolds. Hop in your car or catch the bus right outside the site and discover the charms of Chipping Norton itself, Chadlington, Charbury and Witney for starters.

No stay at Chipping Norton campsite should be without a visit to Stow on the Wold, Bourtonon-the-Water and Batsford. As well as brimming with charm, they boast an eclectic mix of family attractions including Birdland and a model village in Bourton-on-the-Water.

Batsford Arboretum and Hidcote Manor are also worth visiting.

Your Arrival on Site

The nearest train station is 4 miles from site. The nearest bus stop is approx. 25m from site. There are two brown signs off the A361 and one large site sign on entrance.

There is one keypad operated barrier that is automatic on exit. It's locked between 11pm and 7am.

Limited overnight parking is available just outside the main site gate.

The access road is tarmac.

The visitors parking doubles as the overnight which is 10m from the main gate.

The reception/overnight car park will hold three cars.

New arrivals should pull up to reception. The surface is tarmac and level.

There are no designated spaces but limited spaces a short, level distance from the reception.

There is no handrail attached to the reception wall.

There are potted plants along the path.



The reception is clearly signed for arrivals.

The opening hours are 9am-11am then 4pm-6.00pm.

There is a phone number to contact staff between 8am and 8pm. The same number can be used for blue light emergencies outside of these hours.

There are level concrete slabs leading to reception.



There is a slight lip on the entrance door.

There is good clear floor space in reception.

There is no low-level reception counter, but clipboards are available.

PYour Pitch

Cars can be parked next to most pitches on site.

Three pitches are close to the accessible room.

The hardstanding pitches consist of compact smaller gravel.

Many level hardstanding and grass pitches are close to the site road.

The site has a mixture of level and sloping pitches.



Travelling Around Site

The facility blocks have external wall lights. Rest of the site is partially lit from bollards and partially in darkness.



The Facility Block

There is a clear tarmac path leading to the facility block.

There are no steps leading to the block.

There is no incline leading to the block.

There is a single step into gents and ladies.

There is no semi ambulant cubicle in both ladies and gents.

All taps in gents and ladies are push top.

No seats in the showers.

All showers are push button and cannot be adjusted.



There is no step down into the shower tray.

There is low level lighting on the outside of the block throughout the night.

L The Accessible Facilities

There is a flat concrete path.

There is a handrail to the left of the path as you approach the accessible room.

There is flat level access into the accessible facility.

Access is via a radar key.

The toilet has one drop down rail to the left and one wall mounted to the right.

The toilet large flush handle.

There is space to the left of the toilet.

Lever taps are screw type.

A hand dryer is provided.

There's there a mirror and it is full length.

The shower has handrails.

The shower is button controlled, and the temperature and flow can be controlled.

The shower has open access.

The shower head height adjustable.

The floor is non-slip.

There is a low level hairdryer.

There is an emergency cord which can be reached from the floor.

The alarm can be heard around site and in reception.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas



There is good level access to the tiled floored area. The taps are a mixture of screw and lever taps. The washer and dryer are both front loading. An iron is provided which is wall mounted. A free-standing ironing board is provided. The washing up facilities are outdoor but undercover. The taps are a mix of screw top and lever. The outdoor washing up area has one low level sink.

Recreational Areas

The surface of the play area is rubber compound.

There is a raised edge surrounding the play area.

Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is level tarmac access leading to all the refuse areas.

All bins are full size 1100L commercial bins.

There is unrestricted access to firefighting equipment.

There is one assembly point is in main car park outside reception. The other is in the adjacent camping field.

The main car park is tarmac, the camping field is grass.

The assembly points are included in the site leaflet, but campers are also informed on arrival.
