## About Crowden

The Hamlet of Crowden has six houses, a farm, an outdoor education centre and a campsite. There isn't even a post box!

The nearest pub is about 3.5 miles away. It is walkable, using public footpaths and forest tracks, but not along the main road.

Access for walking The Pennine Way is 400 Metres from the site entrance.

There are other higher level walks from the site, into the Peak District National Park, but for walker safety the site staff don't have any information about them. Although we do have maps for lower level valley walks from the site.

The site is sloping on the roads and most grass pitches, but the hardstanding pitches are level and won't need chocks.

There is NO terrestrial TV signal on site, even with a booster unit. Most pitches will have access to a satellite signal, but if the dish is fixed on your unit even that might not be possible on some pitches, because of trees on the site.

Mobile phone signal is also very hit and miss. O2 and EE are generally reliable, although not strong. Vodafone is getting better, but Three and anything working off Three is not available at all.

There is no site WiFi.

There is no payphone on site.

Crowden has Hardstand With Electric pitches, Grass With Electric pitches and large and Narrow Grass Only pitches. There are no Serviced pitches at Crowden.



## Your Arrival on Site

The nearest train station is 5 miles from site. The nearest bus stop is approx. 5 miles from site.

There are two brown tourist signs on the A628, on approach to the site and two large white signs at the turn off from the main road. DO NOT FOLLOW YOUR SAT NAV AND TURN INTO THE HOUSE DRIVE! Turn into the access road for the car park, but drive past the car park entrance, following the smaller white arrowed sign.

There is one keypad operated barrier that is automatic on exit. It's locked between 11pm and 7am.

Overnight parking is not for units arriving, but for vehicles already checked in to the site, the car park can hold at about six cars.

The road surface outside the site is tarmac, leading to loose gravel on site.

New arrivals should park opposite reception. The surface is gravel, and it is reasonably level.

There is no handrail needed at reception.

There are no steps but a gentle incline.

There are potted plants along the path and on the fences.



### Your Check In

The reception is clearly signed for arrivals.

The reception is open between 9am-10:30am then 13.00 to 18.00.

There is a bell located on the reception door which is connected to an on-duty team member.

There are stone slabs outside the reception door.

There is a slight lip on the door.

There is good clear floor space in reception.

There is a low-level reception counter.



### Your Pitch

Cars can be parked next to most pitches on site.

Some Hardstanding pitches and Grass pitches are close to the facilities.

All level hardstanding and some grass pitches are close to the site road.



### Travelling Around Site

There is a 5-mph speed limit on site.

At night there is low level lighting on the outside of all blocks and the rest of the site is dimly lit by hook-up bollards.



### The Facility Block

There is a clear slightly sloping path leading to the facilities.

There are two small steps to the gents and one small step into the ladies, but level, from one direction to the Easy Access/Family Room.

All sinks have push taps throughout.

There are fold down seats in some showers.

The showers are operated by a push button in the men's and ladies and a dial in the Easy Access/Family Room.

The showers in the Ladies and Gents have a slight lip into the cubicle, the Easy Access Room is flat access to the shower.

The facility block has external high level, wall mounted lights.

There is a hairdryer in the ladies toilet and Easy Access Room.



### The Accessible Facilities

There is an Easy Access/Family Room on site, with wheelchair access to the shower and toilet and a baby changing table.

The shower head is adjustable in height and temperature.



### Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

The laundry room is temperature controlled by site staff. It has a washing machine and tumble dryer. Each is coin operated. The approach path is stone slabs and there are two steps to get in the Laundry Room.

All washing up sinks have timed press topped taps.



### Recreational Areas

There are no dedicated recreational areas on site.

There are no steps of kerbs restricting access to the refuse area.

All bins on site are full height industrial 1100L units outside the main entrance. 1.2m high.

There is a fire triangle located at all fire points which have unrestricted access over grass.

The firefighting equipment is accessed over grass.

The assembly points are located by the main entrance which is loose gravel and the other is by the ladies' toilets which is grass.

Campers are briefed about the assembly point in the site brochure. There are clear signs.



### Camping Pods

There is a level stone chipping path leading to all camping pods.

Each pod has a single step up.

There are no sleeping or cooking facilities in the pods, but there is fixed lighting and an electric heater.
