About Dunbar

We are just off the A1, 2.5 miles from Dunbar High Street and Train Station.

The Site is 3 Tiered with generally flat Pitches.

Hardstanding and Grass Pitches, both with and without Electric.

Good Phone Signal, very open Site. No sheltered pitches.

There is no payphone on Site

Good TV signal on most pitches. Very Open Site. No sheltered Pitches

Yes we have Site Wifi with good coverage.



Your Arrival on Site

The nearest train station and bus stop are 3 miles away from site in Dunbar.

There are two brown signs off the A1087, one large site sign on entrance.

One keypad operated barrier that is automatic on exit. It's locked between 11pm and 7am.

The approach road and car park are laid with tarmac.

There is visitors parking which is situated near Reception and outside of the main Barrier

New arrivals should park in the arrivals area, then proceed to check in at reception.

There is no designated accessible parking area.

The main reception car park can hold at least six cars.

There are no handrails outside the reception.

There are no steps or incline.

There are potted plants outside reception.

The Motorhome Service Point is next to the Refuse Area at the Main Car Park.



Your Check In

The reception is clearly signed for arrivals.

The opening times are 9am-10:30am then 4-6pm.

The road surface is level tarmac.

There is a slight lip on the door.

There is good clear floor space in reception.

There is a low-level section of the reception counter.



Your Pitch

Only one car per pitch at all times.

There are pitches close to the accessible room.

All hardstanding pitches are of loose gravel.

Many level hardstanding and grass pitches are close to the site road.

The site is terraced so most pitches get a sea view.



Travelling Around Site

There are speed bumps along the main site road.

At night there is low level lighting on the outside of all blocks and the rest of the site is dimly lit by hook-up bollards. A torch is recommended.

There is one bench outside the Facilities block and 1 bench outside Reception to sit and look at the view.



The Facility Block

There is a clear, well-maintained path leading to the facilities.

There are no steps or inclines around the facility block.

All sinks have screw taps.

There are fixed stools in the shower cubicles.

The showers are operated by a push button in men's and ladies and a dial in the family room.

There are no steps into the showers.

There is low level lighting outside the block throughout the night.

We also have a family room.



The Accessible Facilities

There is a flat level concrete slab path leading to the accessible facility.

There are no handrails approaching the accessible facility.

There is flat level access into the accessible facility.

There are handrails next to the toilet.

There is a regular size flush handle.

There is transfer space to the left of the toilet.

The wash basin cannot be reached from the toilet.

The washbasin has larger than normal lever top taps.

There is a hand dryer located in the room.

There is a low-level mirror above the sink that does not extend to full height.

The shower has a number of handrails.

The shower is dial operated.

The shower is open access, not a cubicle.

The shower head is height adjustable.

The floor is nonslip.

There is a hairdryer, but not low level.

There is an emergency cord next to the toilet and in the shower. Both can be reached from the floor.

The emergency alarm cannot be heard from the reception or the assistants' pitches.

The accessible room can be accessed with a RADAR key.

Laundry & Dishwashing Areas

The laundry area and dishwashing area have level access.

The approach path is concrete.

The taps are screw top and lever taps.

The washing machine is front loading and can be reached from the floor.

The tumble dryers are front loading.

There is a wall mounted iron.

There is a fixed foldaway ironing board

There are both indoor and outdoor washing up facilities available.

All washing up sinks have screw top and lever taps.

There is an outdoor drying area with two rota dryers.

There is one low level sink in the indoor dish wash area.



Recreational Areas

There are no designated recreational areas on site.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

The refuse area is located at the car park near Reception and arrivals area, on a level surface.

General waste bins are chest height, and the recycling bins are chest height and 1100L.

There is a fire triangle located at all water points which has unrestricted access over grass.

The firefighting equipment is accessed over grass.

The assembly points are located at the children's play area and at the top of the site.

The assembly points are accessed on grass.
