About Graffham

Down an access lane.

One mile from Graffham Village, which has a village shop and café. 3 pubs within walking distance.

With walks onto the South Downs. Petworth House is 5miles from site.



Close by is Graffham Down Reserves, which has lots of different birds, including rare Nightjars which can be found at dusk. Also butterflies and flowers. Weald & Downland living museum (where the repair shop is filmed) is 9 miles away.

We Also have a Local Brewery called Langham Brewery which is 3.5 miles from site. You can expect to be woken up with the morning chorus, as we have many birds on site. Towards the end of the season, we have lots of varieties of Fungi.

The Campsite is within a wood, not many pitches are level, so levelling ramps are advised.

We have some grass pitches, but most are sandy with some roots.

We have pitches with Electric or non-Electric. Many of our pitches are in secluded spots.

Mobile signal is hit and miss depending on who your provider is. There is no Payphone on site.

TV can be hit and miss due to location and tree coverage across the site. Although we've had no complaints.

Wi-Fi is limited and available only around reception area.



Your Arrival on Site

The nearest train station is 8.5 miles from site.

There are two brown signs, one off the A285 and another at the next junction indicating a left turn and site 400 yards on the left.

One keypad operated entrance barrier and one barrier automatic on exit. These are locked between 11pm and 7am.

The visitor's parking is located at the main gate opposite reception, and doubles as the overnight parking.

The main reception car park can hold four cars.

New arrivals should pull up at reception. The surface is gravel and slightly inclined.

There are no steps to the reception just a gravel and slabbed gentle incline.

There are potted plants and seating areas surround the reception.



Your Check In



The reception is clearly signed for arrivals.

The opening hours are 9am-10:30am then 1pm-6pm.

There is a buzzer located on the reception door which is connected to an on-duty team member.

There are level concrete slabs.

There is a slight lip on the entrance door.

There is good clear floor space in reception.

There is no low-level reception counter, but clipboards are available.



Your Pitch

Cars can be parked next to most pitches on site.

Chocks may be needed on some pitches.

Most pitches are under trees.

There are no hardstanding pitches.

There are no pitches close to accessible facilities.



Travelling Around Site

At night there is lighting on the outside of all blocks.

There are a small number of benches dotted around the site.



The Facility Block

There is a clear, well-maintained path leading to the facilities.

All sinks have screw taps.

There are seats available for the showers.



The showers are operated by dial.

There are three ladies' showers and three gents.



The Accessible Facilities

There is a flat level concrete slab path leading to the accessible facility.

There is also a tarmac wheelchair slope for access to the facility.

There is a raised lip at door entrance.

There are handrails next to the toilet.

There is a regular size flush handle.

There is transfer space to the left of the toilet.

The wash basin has larger than normal lever top taps.

There is a low-level mirror above the sink that does not extend to full height.

The shower has a number of handrails.

The shower is dial operated.

The shower is open access, not a cubicle.

The shower head is height adjustable.

The floor is nonslip.

There is an emergency chord next to the toilet and shower; this can be reached from the floor.

The emergency alarm can be heard from both staff pitches and also the reception.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

The laundry and food preparation areas both have level access.

The approach path is concrete.

The taps are screw top.



The washing machine is front loading and can be reached from the floor.

The tumble dryer is front loading and stacked on top of the washing machine.

There is a wall mounted iron.

There is an ironing board.

There are both indoor and outdoor washing up facilities available.

All washing sinks have screw taps.



Recreational Areas

There are no designated recreational areas on site.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

The waste bins are in the main car park opposite reception. Any items put into the Recycle bin must be but in loose, not in bags.

There are no steps restricting access to the refuse bins.

There are both recycle and general waste bins and a Food bin. Recycle must be put in loose, not in a bag.

All bins on site are full height industrial 1100L units.

There is a fire triangle located at all water points which has unrestricted access over grass.

The firefighting equipment is accessed over grass.

The assembly points are located in the main car park, which is loose gravel situated opposite reception, and the other is grass covered and located outside the main facility block.

These areas are clearly marked and are written in the site information booklet.
