About Leek Campsite

Our Leek campsite, located in Staffordshire Moorlands and just a stone's throw away from the southern Peak District, will appeal to campers who enjoy nothing more than a good walk in a scenic location.

View to the north of the campsite reveal The Roaches, situated only a short distance away.

Leek campsite is also well placed to explore the Potteries. Stoke-on-Trent, South of the site has several museums and galleries dedicated to the ceramic industry, which gave the Potteries its name.

Your Arrival on Site

Train Station 10 miles from site, bus stop 400 meters.

Two site signs and two Brown signs half a mile before site entrance.

1 entrance barrier and 1 exit barrier.

Approach road surface is tarmac.

Visitors parking available after the entrance barrier.

New arrivals should pull up at Reception barrier and road is reasonably level.

One accessible space within the site, outside reception block.

There is a handrail which is attached to reception entrance.

No steps or steep inclines.



Your Check In

The Reception is clearly signed for arrivals.

Reception/Shop opening hours are 9am – 10:30am and 4:30pm – 6:00pm.

Check in is available from 1pm until 8pm.

For out of hours there is an emergency mobile telephone number located on related signage on the office door.

Access to reception up a slight incline.

Floor is clear from clutter.



Your Pitch

Cars can be parked next to most pitches on site.

Six pitches close to the accessible room.

Hardstanding's are a mixture of gravel and concrete.

Many levels hard standing and grass pitches. Site is a mixture of level and slightly sloping pitches.



Travelling Around Site

There are no speedbumps on site.

Facility blocks have external wall lights, rest of site is lit from bollards.

Reception carpark will hold 4 cars.



The Facility Block

There is a clear Tarmac path leading to the facility block.

No steps or ramps leading to the block, there is a single step into the gents and ladies.

There are no semi-ambulant cubicles.

Taps are screw top.

Single weight rated stools in each shower cubicle.

Showers are push button, temperatures cannot be adjusted.

There is a step down in to the shower tray.

There is low level lighting on the outside of the block throughout the night.



The Accessible Facilities

There is a flat Tarmac path.

Handrail opposite accessible facilities.

Uneven road to flat tarmac leading to facilities.

The toilet has one drop down rail to the left, Transfer space to the left.

Washbasin cannot be reached from the toilet; taps are lever top.

There is a hand dryer, there is a mirror but not full length.

The shower has handrails. The shower is dial operated. Shower is open access. Shower head is height adjustable; Floor is non-slip.

There is no hair dryer.

There are 2 emergency chords that can be reached from the floor.

The alarm cannot be heard from the staff pitches.

The alarm can be heard from the reception.

Access via RADAR key system.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

These areas have good level access.

Surface leading to these facilities is paved and tarmac.

Taps are screw top.

Washing machines are front loading, at least one washing machine can be loaded from the floor.

Tumble dryer is front loading and floor level.

There is a wall mounted iron and a freestanding ironing board.

There are indoor washing up facilities available, with screw taps.

There is no outdoor drying area.



Recreational Areas

There is no indoor recreation area.

There is an outdoor recreation area. Access is over a slightly sloping gravel path.

There is a bench with seating near the play area.

Play area surface is rubber.

There is a raised edge surrounding the play area.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is flat level access leading to the refuse area.

The path is tarmac.

There are no steps or kerbs. There are no handrails.

Waste containers 1.2m high. Commercial euro type bins. There are fire triangles on all water points.

There is unrestricted access to all firefighting equipment on site.

The fire assembly points are in the motor home service point outside information room and in the carpark next to manager's cottage. Both assembly point surfaces are tarmac. Assembly points are included in the site leaflet, but campers are also informed on arrival.
