About Llanystumdwy

Our Llanystumdwy Club campsite in North West Wales is located between mountains and sea in An Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. Its position makes it ideal for exploring both the Llyn Peninsula and Snowdonia National Park – both great walking areas.

Lovely views extend over the rolling countryside from the campsite which is bordered by tree and dry stone walls.

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It's a short walk to the village of Llanystumdwy. Here you'll find a pub serving home-cooked food and a museum dedicated to Lloyd George who lived in the village until the age of 16.

Criccieth to the east of the campsite has a castle and plenty of independent shops, pubs, cafes and restaurants. It also has a long esplanade along the seafront and a sandy beach.

Further on Porthmadog is the gateway to the Snowdonia National Park. It's also home to the Ffestiniog and Welsh High Railways. Jump on a train at either end of the town, enjoy the mountain scenery.



Your Arrival on Site

The nearest train station is 2 miles away at Criccieth. The bus stops at entrance to site (both ways).

Porthmadog to Pwllheli route is a request stop.

There is one brown sign on the main road A497 and two Club signs at the main entrance.

There are three barriers with signs with the site opening and closing times.

There is no entrance to site after 11pm, only pedestrian access.

The approach road is tarmac.

New arrivals should pull up to reception, the surface is tarmac and on a slope.

There are no designated accessible parking spaces.

There is no car park on site and no overnight car park. Overnight parking is only available by the side of a busy B-road which runs past site entrance.

The road into site is on a slope, as is the rest of the site.



Your Check In

The reception is clearly signed.

Opening hours are 9am to 10.30am and 4pm to 6pm at the height of season. 9am to 10am then 4pm to 5pm at quieter times.

For out of hours, ring the doorbell which is clearly signed on door.

There is no level access leading to reception. There is one step leading to reception and one leading in.

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Floor space is clear from clutter though very limited for space.



Your Pitch

Cars can be parked next to units on all pitches.

There are four hardstanding pitches close to the accessible facility.



Travelling Around Site

There are speedbumps on the entrance road but not on the rest of the site.

Facility blocks and reception are lit at night. The rest of the site is unlit.



The Facility Block

There is a clear well-maintained path leading to the facility block.

On the left side of building there are 3 steps up to both ladies and gents facilities, and on the right side of building there is a sloping ramp leading to all facilities.

All ladies and gents facilities have a step at the entrance.

The taps are turn and lever tops.

The showers are dial operated.

The showers do not have steps.

The block is light at night.



The Accessible Facilities

Access to the accessible facilities is over a sloping path.

There are no handrails on the outside.

There is a lip on the entrance.

The toilet has handrails and a regular flush handle with transfer space to the right of the toilet.

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The washbasin cannot be reached from the toilet. The taps are lever top.

There is a hand dryer and two mirrors set at different heights.

The shower has handrails and is dial operated with open access and a height adjustable shower head.

The floor is tiled.

There is a hairdryer.

There is an emergency cord that can be reached from the floor.

The alarm can be heard from the staff pitches and reception.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

The path leading up to this area is tarmac and there is a one-inch lip at entrance.

Taps are lever and screw top.

The washing machine is front loading and can be loaded at floor level.

There is one floor level front loading dryer.

There is a wall mounted iron and freestanding ironing board.

There are indoor washing up facilities. The taps are lever and twist top.



Recreational Areas

There are no recreational areas on site.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

Access to the refuse area is via a sloped road.

The path is tarmac and gravel.

There is no step or kerb.

There are no handrails.

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The wastebins are 1100L commercial containers and are 1.2m high.

There are two fire triangles in the top field, one at each water point, one outside the toilets, one in the bottom field and one by the CDP.

There is unrestricted access to firefighting equipment.

There is only one assembly point which is next to the site manager's pitch.

The assembly point surface is tarmac and grass.
