About Lynton

Lynton Club site is situated just over 1 mile outside the town of Lynton on foot, or 2 miles by car.

The site is sloping with some hedges around the perimeter. There is no dog walk or games area on site. The site offers a mixture of grass only, grass with electric and hardstanding with electric pictures.



There are no accessible facilities available at Lynton.

Mobile signal is good on major networks. TV reception is adequate.



Your Arrival on Site

Bus stop: half mile; Barnstable train station: 19 miles

Lynton has 2 local taxi companies

There is a standard brown sign with a caravan on it at the Caffyn's cross turn off on the A39. Signs are up with appropriate information.

This campsite doesn't have overnight parking.

Approach is tarmac via a narrow country lane (so no arrivals before 1pm). There is no access to the site after 11pm.

Reception is well signed. Campsite isn't level.

There is no designated accessible parking space.

There are no handrails. There are no steps or steep inclines into reception.



Your Check In

The reception is in the building as you drive in it is clearly signed, It is accessed via slight sloping paving. There is a small threshold with a wide doorway leading into reception.

The reception is manned during shop hours 9am till 10.30am and 4pm to 6pm. Access is restricted. Once inside the floor space is free form clutter.

When reception is unattended there is staff contact details on the door. The latest assisted pitching is 8pm. pre-booked campers may be given instructions should their arrival be delayed. Only Backpackers can arrive after 8pm with no prior booking.

Staff are not on duty after 8pm but an emergency contact number can be found in site welcome leaflet and on reception door.





Your Pitch

There are pitches available where 1 car can be parked next to its unit. Additional vehicles can park in the visitor parking area, space permitting.

The hardstanding pitches are gravel.

There are fairly level pitches near the temporary facilities.

There are no accessible facilities on site.



Travelling Around Site

Roads on site are a mixture of tarmac and gravel. There are no speedbumps on site. There is a 5mph speed limit.

The site is reasonably lit at night.

The only footpath on site is to the chemical disposal point.

There is no reception carpark. There is a grass area outside of campsite where cars can park overnight.



The Facility Block

Currently there are temporary facilities situated on two hardstanding gravel pitches. These are lit up at night. There are 2 separate shower units on one pitch and a male and female toilet on the second pitch. All the facilities are accessed via 3 metal steps with handrails.

The shower cubicles have drop down seating with a maximum weight of 160KG

The facilities are not suitable for wheelchair users, and there are no emergency cords in any of the facilities.

There are only small hand basins in the toilet facilities with hot water push taps.

Due to the temporary nature of the facilities please check with the site or customer contact centre for any clarification.





The Accessible Facilities

There are no accessible facilities on site.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

There is currently no Laundry or Food preparation area or indoor washing up facilities.



Recreational Areas

There is no indoor recreation area.

There is an outdoor children's play area. Containing a double swing and combined slide/climbing frame. It is slightly sloping. There is seating near the play area.

Play surface is bark.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is a flat level access to the refuse area which is situated to the right of the site entrance. The path is paved and concrete. There are no handrails. The waste containers are 1.3m high and have lift up lids.

The water point opposite pitch 24 has level access from the gravel road. The grey waste drain and drinking water point are on a slightly raised area (approx. 15cm). The surrounding fence is 1m high with a fire point.

The water point opposite pitch 49 has two accesses, one with steps up and the other slightly sloping down with no steps. The grey waste drain and the drinking water point are on a slightly raised area (approx. 15cm). The surrounding fence is 1m high with a fire point.

The Motorhome service point has a level drive over grid, and a secondary water pointset in a concrete surround which is up to 30cm high in some areas. There is no level access to the secondary water point, but it is unfenced, and the drinking water tap is accessible.

There are two fire assembly points: One by the main entrance to the site and one by the gate to the right of the CDP.



Further fire extinguishers held within fire boxes are situated near the bin compound entrance, the motorhome service point, in the top camping field and by the temporary toilets. There is unrestricted access to all firefighting equipment.
