About Mablethorpe

Mablethorpe is a quiet site and is situated a mile from the town centre and beach which is a typical bucket and spade seaside resort with pubs and restaurants and shops.

There is also a new complex in the high street which is an activity centre and is fun for all ages. Good local taxi service and the bus stop is about 20 minutes' walk with buses to Skegness or Louth.





Your Arrival on Site

Train Station is in Skegness 20 miles away and the bus station is at the back of the Co-op supermarket 1 mile away.

There is one brown sign on the Alford Road coming into Mablethorpe on the A1104 The brown sign is just after the petrol station on the A1104 pointing to the right down Church Lane the site is at the end of Church Lane where there are large club signs on the entrance to the site.

There are two barriers; one for entering the site this has a keypad. The code for this is given on the information sheet when members check in to reception.

The exit barrier is automatic; both barriers close at 11pm and reopen at 7am.

Overnight parking is available in the car park which is situated on the left hand side as you enter the site.

The road into the site is tarmac but it is gravel in the car park. The road on site is tarmac. For overnight parking, there is parking in the car park as described above.

New arrivals should pull to the side of the wooden fencing on the right hand side as the large sign indicates. This area is tarmac and level and only 10m from the reception.

There is no designated accessible parking space.

There are no handrails leading up to the reception.

Only a very small incline to reception.



Your Check In

The reception is clearly signed.

Arrival times are from 1pm - 8pm

These times are clearly displayed on the reception door and in the information leaflet that members and non-members get given when they check in.

For out of hours assistance, there is an emergency telephone number that is on a notice which is displayed in the window of the reception door when the reception is closed.

There are 10 concrete slabs from the tarmac road to the reception door with a very small incline.



There are no access issues when entering reception.

There is good open space in the reception area with no clutter o In reception there is a low level reception counter.



Your Pitch

Cars can be parked by the side of all pitches.

There are 6 pitches proximity to the accessible room.

There are also 6 grass electric pitches also close to the accessible room.

All the hard standing pitches are gravel pitches o All the pitches are level.



Travelling Around Site

There are 6 speedbumps on site.

Reception and facilities are both very well lit up and are open 24 hours a day



The Facility Block

There is a clear level and well-maintained tarmac path all around the facility block

There are no steps to any of the rooms to the facility block.

There is no ramp.

No semi ambulant cubicle in the main block.

All taps in the facility block are push button type except for the accessible facilities.

There are folding seats fitted in every shower cubicle in the facility block.

All showers are push button in both ladies and gents except for the accessible and family room facilities.

No steps into any of the showers in the facility block

There is lighting all around the facility block at night.





The Accessible Facilities

There is a flat level path leading to the accessible facility.

There are no handrails leading to the accessible room.

There is flat level access into the room.

The toilet has handrails and a regular sized flush handle. There is transfer space to the left-hand side.

The washbasin cannot be reached from the toilet.

Taps are lever top.

There is a hand dryer.

There is a mirror. It is not full length.

The shower has handrails is dial operated and has an adjustable shower head.

There is a fold down seat for the shower.

The floor is non-slip, there is a hair dryer.

There is an emergency chord that can be reached from the floor.

The alarm can be heard from the staff pitches.

The alarm can be heard from reception.

The room is accessed using a RADAR key this door opens outwards.

There is a slight threshold.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

All three rooms have good level access.



Surface leading to these areas is tarmac.

There are two sinks in the laundry, four sinks in the dishwashing and one sink in the CDP and are all push button type.

The dryer and washing machines are fixed one on top of the other. The dryer is on the top, so they are both front loaders. The washing machine can be loaded from the floor.

The dryer is a front loader but not floor level.

There is a wall mounted iron and wall mounted ironing board.

There is an indoor washing up facility.

Taps are push button type.

There are no outdoor drying area.



Recreational Areas

There is no indoor recreation area.

There is an outdoor recreation area. Access is over grass and all level.

There is no seating available near the play area.

Play area surface is rubber.

There is a raised edge surrounding the play area.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is a flat level path leading to the refuse area.

There are no steps or kerbs or handrails.

Normal domestic waste bins on site. We have fire triangles on site.

There is unrestricted access to all firefighting equipment.

Assembly points are outside main reception and back gate.



Assembly point surfaces are gravel and grass.
