About Nottingham

The site is 6 miles from the centre of Nottingham, is accessed via the A52 & A46. There is a good bus service to Nottingham from the Shepherds Park & Ride stop 0.3 miles away. The terrain is very flat and mostly surrounded by trees with large areas of open field, providing grass pitches. The pitch mix is hard standing with electric, grass with electric (booking restriction on motorhomes larger than 6.5m due to ground conditions during wet periods), grass only (restrictions as GWE) and Jumbo grass only.



Mobile phone signals vary across the site but is mostly reasonable and the site Wi-Fi is good.

TV signals also vary across the site, mostly because of the trees.

There is an on-site coffee shop, selling hot and cold drinks, cakes and bakes including a few savoury treats. The opening hours are 9 to 5 Monday to Sunday.

Your Arrival on Site

Earliest arrival on site is 1pm, please consider if you arrive early on a busy day you may cause a queue affecting traffic on Stragglethorpe Road which is a busy link road.

Some sat nav systems will want to take you past the site and on to Cotgrave, please consider:

From the A52 the site is on the left off Stragglethorpe Road, DO NOT TURN RIGHT down Main Road, go under the bridge and we are almost immediately on the left. From the A46, stay on Stragglethorpe Road for approximately 2 miles and just before the overhead bridge, the site is on the right.

Entrance to the site is via a mechanical barrier, operated by electronic keypad. On arrival, pull up to the arrivals sign to the left and a member of staff will be there to welcome you. Note that the barrier is also the exit barrier, so please don't pull up to it, leave enough space for those leaving site.

Barriers lock down between 11pm and 7am. There is a small visitor car park with approximately 10 parking spaces and pedestrian access onto site after hours.

There is no designated accessible car parking on site or in the visitor's car park however if you communicate any specific requirements we will try to accommodate your needs.

There is a slight incline up to the reception, shop and coffee shop via a tarmac path.

<u> ^</u>^ Your Check In

Reception is clearly sign posted. When you arrive, park on the left at the arrivals sign and reception is up the path to your right and then on your left. You can't miss it.

Reception opening hours are 9am to 10:30am and 1pm to 6pm. There are staff on duty until 8pm to welcome arrivals.

For out of hours assistance, there is an emergency telephone number that is on an information board at Reception & on a notice which is displayed in the window of the reception door when the reception is closed.



There is good open space in the reception area.

Your Pitch

Campers can park their cars on their pitch with their unit or on the grass to the left-hand side, weather and ground conditions permitting.

There are only a few pitches with good access to / near the facilities. If you have access needs, please state on your booking in advance so we can accommodate you as best we can.

There are pitches off the tarmac road, but most of our pitches are off gravel tracks. All pitches are level.

There are 40 hard standing pitches and 112 Grass.

There are no fully serviced pitches.



Travelling Around Site

The site roads and tracks are a combination of tarmac and gravel. There are speed bumps on the tarmac road.

The entrance, reception and facilities buildings are well illuminated however across the site, in the fields there is very little lighting and a torch is recommended when walking around at night.



The Facility Block

The facilities block is level access and the paths leading up to the building are clear and well maintained.

There is an easy access room (see below) but no ambulant accessible cubicles.

Showers are larger than average with a seat / shelf for clothes and toiletries and hooks for hanging items. There are also wash basins in the cubicles with mirrors over. All showers are push button operated with a level of temperature control.

Floors are all level, less the falls for drainage so no steps. Floor surfaces are anti-slip vinyl.

The facilities are well lit at night.



The Accessible Facilities

The facility is level access, with no steps or ramps on approach. There are no handrails outside.

The WC has handrails and a large lever flush. There is transfer space to one side, the WHB can be reached from the WC. The WHB taps are push operated. There is a mirror over the basin.

The shower area is now fitted with wall mounted drop down seat and rails. The shower is push button operated with a level of temperature control via a dial and has a hose that is height adjustable.

Floor surfaces are anti-slip vinyl.

There is an emergency pull cord that can be reached from the floor.

The hand dryer and hair dryer are in the lobby on exiting the room. Here there is also a fulllength mirror.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

The facility is level access, with no steps or ramps on approach.

There is a washing machine and tumble dryer, both token operated. Tokens and wash powder / tablets can be purchased via card payment from the site shop.

There is a sink and drainer for handwashing. Taps are push operation.

There is a bench to sit on and table for folding clothes. An ironing board is provided; the iron can be requested from reception.

There is no outdoor drying facility.



Recreational Areas

There is an outdoor children's play area with a separate ball game enclosure, for football and basketball.

Access to the play area is over a gravel track or grass. There is seating available outside the play area.

Ground surface is artificial grass.

There is an area in the coffee shop reception where games are available to play.





Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is flat level access leading to the refuse area, bins are 1190mm height.

There are fire call points (triangles) and extinguishers across the site at intervals of no more than 90m.

Approach to call points is level access over grass in most cases.

The fire assembly points are the coffee shop and visitor car park.
