Oban also has a few supermarkets, Tesco's being the largest. Aldi, Lidl, M&S food court are all close to each other with good parking for cars, Campers and motor homes.
The one-way system in the town can be busy but it's easy to manoeuvre through to get to the parking.
Oban has 2 cathedrals, and the most distinctive landmark is McCraig's Tower (looks like a Colosseum tower)



Your Arrival on Site

Bus stops approx. 0.5 mile -APP available - Westcoast motors.
Main line railway station – Oban 13 miles.
Site signs and flagpole at entrance opposite school signs in Barcaldine.
Electronic entrance and exit barriers. Keypad entrance, automatic exit.
Signage "Gates closed to vehicles 11pm – 7am"
Approach is concrete leading onto stone and then tarmac.
Visitors' car park signed prior to site main entrance.
Arrivals should park outside of reception, level tarmac.
There is no designated accessible parking on site.
There are no handrails leading to reception.
2 steps leading into reception.



Your Check In

Reception is clearly signed.

Opening hours are 9am -10.30am & 4pm – 6pm

For out of hours contact, in cases of 999 type of emergency use the emergency phone.
Number is on arrival notice.
2 steps leading into reception.

Access is not level.

Once inside the floor is free from clutter.
Also have a small shop, selling essentials and ice cream.
Entrance same as the office, right next door.



Your Pitch

Pitches are available where cars can be parked next to units.

Hardstanding's are available close to the accessible facility.

Hardstanding pitches are gravel.

There are several level pitches close to the facility block.



Travelling Around Site

External door lights to facility block and reception. Water points and bollards are also lit.



The Facility Block

There is a clear, well-maintained path leading to the facility block.

There are steps.

There is a gentle sloped ramp.

Via the ramp all level access to the accessible room, washing up area, parent and child, ladies and gents. One gent's entrance has 4 steps up to door.

There is a semi-ambulant cubicle.

Mixture of taps.

Fixed bench type seating in the gents and ladies with freestanding chair in the accessible room and parent and child room.

Showers are pushing button. Lever type in accessible and parent and child.

Showers do not have a step.

The facility block is lit at night



The Accessible Facilities

There is a sloped level path leading to the accessible facility.

There are handrails leading to the facility.

There is flat level access in to the accessible facility.

The toilet has handrails.

The toilet has a larger flush handle.

The toilet has transfer space.

The washbasin can be reached from the toilet.

Taps are lever top. There is a hand dryer

There is a mirror. It is not full length.

The shower has handrails.

The shower is lever operated.

Shower is open access with folding screen (knee height)

Shower head is height adjustable.

Floor is non-slip.

There is no hair dryer.

There is an emergency cord that can be reached from the floor.
The alarm cannot be heard from the staff pitches or reception.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

Dishwash is on level via ramp. Food prep is possible.
Access to these areas is via tarmac.

Laundry has 12cm step
Standard screw taps in laundry, lever in dishwashing.

Washing machines are front loading.

At least one washing machine can be loaded from the floor.

Tumble dryers are front loading and floor level.

There is a wall mounted iron and ironing board.
There are indoor washing up areas.
Taps are lever top.

There are two rotary dryers- whirly gigs. Pegs needed.



Recreational Areas

There is no indoor recreation area.

There is no children's play area.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

Dustbins for B-B-Q ash only, at water points – grass / concrete slope / flat concrete
No defined path as such.

Slight concrete sloping ramp into the water point.

There are no handrails.

Rubbish and recycle bin area on level down the drive outside main gate.
Recycling skips with flip lid 1.2m high.

There are fire triangles on site.

There is unrestricted access to firefighting equipment.

Assembly point 1 – Outside of site main entrance gate.

Assembly point 2 – By the farm gates.

Point 1 surface is – Gravel.

Point 2 surface is – Grass / tarmac.
