Your Arrival on Site

The nearest train station 7 miles from site. There is a bus station in Llandovery 7 miles from site.

There is one brown sign from Llandovery, two large site signs on entrance.

There is one keypad operated barrier that is automatic on exit. It's locked between 11pm and 7am.



The visitor's car park can hold at least eight cars.

Overnight parking for cars is available in the visitor's car park.

The visitors parking doubles as the overnight which is 30m from the main gate.

The road surface is tarmac leading to loose gravel.

New arrivals should pull up to reception. The surface is tarmac and its reasonably level.

There is no handrail attached to the reception wall.

There are no steps but a gentle incline.

There is a slight lip on the reception door.

There are potted plants along the path.



Your Check In

The reception is clearly signed for arrivals.

Reception opening hours are 9am-10:30am then 4pm-6pm.

For arrival between 6pm - 8pm, there is a bell located to the right of the reception door which is connected to an on-duty team member.

There are level concrete slabs.

There is a slight lip on the door.

There is good clear floor space in reception.



Your Pitch

Cars can be parked next to most pitches on site.

There are six pitches close to the accessible room. Four are gravel hardstanding with electric and two are grass with electric.

There are many level hardstanding and grass pitches close to the site road.





Travelling Around Site

There is no speed bump along the main site road.

At night there is low level lighting on the outside of all blocks and the rest of the site is dimly lit by hook-up bollards.

There are a small number of benches dotted around the site.



The Facility Block

There is a clear, well maintained level path leading to the facilities.

There is one step into the ladies and gents main door. There are no steps into the accessible room.

Some sinks have lever taps.

There are solid seats in all showers.

The showers are operated by a dial in the men's and ladies and a dial in the accessible facility.

The showers have no steps.

The facility block has ceiling mounted lights.



The Accessible Facilities

There is a flat level concrete slab path leading to the accessible facility.

There are no handrails leading to the accessible facility.

There is flat level access into the accessible facility.

There are handrails next to the toilet.

There is a larger size flush handle.

There is transfer space to the right of the toilet as you look at it.

The wash basin cannot be reached from the toilet.

The wash basin has a normal lever top tap.



There is a hand dryer located in the room.

There is a low-level mirror above the sink that does not extend to full height.

The shower has a number of handrails.

The shower is dial operated.

The shower is open access, not a cubicle.

The shower head is height adjustable.

The floor is nonslip.

There is a hairdryer.

There is an emergency cord next to the toilet and in the shower. Both can be reached from the floor

The emergency alarm can be heard from both staff pitches and reception.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

The laundry and food preparation areas both have level access over slabs.

The taps are screw top.

The washing machine is front loading and can be reached from the floor.

The tumble dryer is front loading and can be reached from the floor.

There is a wall mounted iron.

There is a pull up ironing board attached to the wall.

There are indoor washing up facilities available.

All washing up sinks have screw top taps.

There is an outdoor drying area with one rotary dryer.

There is no low-level sink in the washing up area.





Recreational Areas

There is no outdoor children play area.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is a low step leading up to each of the two waste/water points.

There is a waist high fence either side of the entrance step (the rest is the same).

General waste bins on site are full height industrial 1100L units and are 1.2m high. The glass, plastic and tins bins are 240L and are 1m high

There is a fire triangle located at all water points and on the side of the facility block, which have unrestricted access over grass.

The firefighting equipment is accessed over grass.

The fire assemble points are located by the flagpole and on the entrance road.

The fire assembly points are marked on the welcome site leaflet and are clearly marked by signs on the site.
