About Scone

Scone is a beautiful tree lined site, sitting adjacent to Perth Racecourse, within the Scone Palace estate.

The main local attractions are the racecourse and of course Scone Palace itself, historic crowning place of Scottish Kings. The palace is a two mile walk from the site, or it has ample parking if you prefer to drive.

The City of Perth is about three miles from site offering theatres, shopping and history. The Stone of Scone is now housed in Perth Museum.

With easy access to main road network Stirling is only thirty minutes away, with Edinburgh and Glasgow both little over an hour away. For those wishing to head north within minutes of leaving the site you can be on the A9 trunk road.



Your Arrival on Site

Train 4 miles from site. Bus stop 1 mile

From a large Brown sign located at Scone Palace begin to follow brown signs directing to Racecourse and Campsite. Drive into the racecourse, campsite is on your right after 500yds.

One keypad operated barrier for entry, automatic for exit. Locked between 11pm – 7am. There is a large carpark located within the site boundary for out of hours arrivals. Arrivals between 8pm – 11pm are left instructions on the reception door.

Approach is tarmac leading to gravel.

New Arrivals should pull up in car park. The surface is tarmac and level. Signs direct to parking

There is one dedicated accessible parking. There is a handrail just outside reception.

From car park reception is accessed along a short gravel path. There are no steps but a gentle incline on concrete ramp leading to reception door from car park. One step from same ramp to campsite.



Your Check In

Reception is clearly signed.

Opening hours are 9am - 10:30am & 4pm - 6pm (3pm-5pm Oct to season end)

Instructions on how to contact staff out of these hours are displayed on reception door.

Slight lip on door.

There are no access issues entering reception.

Floor space is clear from clutter.



Your Pitch

All pitches can accommodate a car.

Several pitches are available close to the facilities.

Hardstanding pitches are loose large gravel.

All pitches are level.

3 super services pitches available with hookup, drain and tap. All level.



Travelling Around Site

There are speedbumps on site.

There are 12 lights around facilities, 4 outside receptions, 2 on drive leading onto site.

All water points have lighting and some hook up bollards.

Overnight carpark and reception carpark will hold 11 cars.



The Facility Block

There is a clear, well maintained path leading to the facility block.

No steps or ramps.

Level access into the block

There are no semi-ambulant cubicles.

Lever top on basins

Wall hung seats in the showers
Showers are push button.
No steps in the showers
Facility block is lit at night.
The Accessible Facilities
There is a flat concrete path leading to the accessible facility.
There are no handrails leading to the facility.
There is level access into the room.
Toilet has handrails. Toilet has a larger flush handle.
Transfer space to the left.
Washbasin can be reached from the toilet.
Taps are lever top, There is a hand dryer.
Vanity mirror above hand basin. No full length mirror.
The shower has handrails.
Shower is dial operated.
Shower is open access.
Shower head is height adjustable.
Floor is non-slip.
There is a hair dryer.

Emergency cord can be reached from the floor.

Alarm cannot be heard from the reception or staff pitches.

Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

These areas have good, level access.

A concrete path leads to these areas.

Taps are lever top.

Washing machines are front loading and floor level. Tumble dryers are front loading and stacked.

There is a wall mounted iron and ironing board.

There are indoor washing up facilities.

Taps are lever top, there are no outdoor drying areas.



Recreational Areas

No indoor recreation area.

There is an outdoor recreation area.

Flat level access, gravelled path.

One bench overlooking play area, surface is rubber. No raised edge surrounding the play area.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is flat level access to the refuse area over a tarmac path.

No steps or kerbs, no handrails.

Waste containers are chest height.

Fire triangles on all water points.

There is unrestricted access to firefighting equipment. Assembly points are in the racecourse car park at site entrance and at the end of dog walk at rear of site.

Car park surface is tarmac. Dog walk uneven copse area.
