About St David's

There are stunning views from our campsite near Pembrokeshire's Heritage Coast in South Wales.

If you're looking for a campsite with stunning sea views, magnificent sunsets and brisk walks our St David's Club campsite could be for you. Just a mile from the Heritage Coast, visitors to this attractive campsite will also have the chance to enjoy the area's historic buildings, traditional arts and crafts and plentiful wildlife.





Your Arrival on Site

Summer bus (Jun, July and Aug) can be hailed from site entrance. Service bus stop is aprox 1 mile from entrance. Train station Haverfordwest 15 miles.

Follow map rather than rely on Sat Nav. Large sign at site entrance. Approach is tarmac to stone. There is no overnight parking.

New arrivals should pull up at reception. Roads are sloping & stone.

There is no designated accessible parking.

There is currently no mobile phone signal.

No handrails, or steps but a slight incline.



Your Check In

Reception is clearly signed. Opening hours are 9am - 10:30am & 4:00pm -6:00pm.

For out of hours, ring reception bell or follow instructions on door. Approach to reception is not level. One step up to reception entrance.

Floor is clear from clutter.



Your Pitch

Pitches are available where cars can be parked next to camper's units.

There are no hardstanding pitches close to an accessible facility. Hardstanding's are gravel.

There are no level pitches that are close to facility blocks.

Levelling ramps are required for most pitches.



Travelling Around Site

All site roads are stone. There is a speed limit around the site of 5mph. A one-way system is in operation, and this is clearly signed.

There are no speed bumps on site. Pitches unlit. Facility block & reception have wall lights.



No reception or overnight carpark.



The Facility Block

There is a clear well-maintained path leading to the facilities.

There are no steps but a downward slope leading to the facilities.

There is level access into the facility block as you enter.

There are no semi-ambulant cubicles.

Taps are screw top. There are seats in the showers.

Showers are push button, and have a step in.

Facility block is lit at night

Hygiene bins are provided in both ladies and gents.

There is a baby changing unit in the ladies.



The Accessible Facilities

There is no dedicated accessible facility on site. All showers have single step up and have grab handles.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

There is a single step up into the laundry/dishwash room which has a level floor.

Taps are screw top.

Washing machine are floor level and front loading, Tumble driers are front loading and stacked.

There is no iron.

Indoor washing up facilities are available.



Recreational Areas



No indoor recreation area. No children's play area.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is no flat level access to the refuse area. Path is sloping gravel and grass. Bin area is gravel.

There are steps leading to the one water point on site.

There is no Motorhome Service Point.

There is a chemical disposal point next to facilities block. Handwashing is available in laundry. There is a single step up into room with a level floor.

There are no handrails. Bins are 1m high. Wheelie bins are 1.5m high.

There is a fire triangle on site. There is unrestricted access to firefighting equipment.

Fire assembly point 1 is at the main entrance gate.

Fire assembly point 2 is at the refuse bin area next to facilities block.

Assembly point 1 surface is concrete. Assembly point 2 is gravel.
