About St Neots

Situated on the banks of the Great Ouse. Walkers, cyclists and fishermen will love our St Neots Club Site.

From 16 June, fishing is available on site until the site closes for the season. Within strolling distance, you'll find a lovely pub.

Pleasant riverside walks take you into St Neots and its independent shops, national retailers and varied eateries.



The town also have several parks including St Neots Common, Riverside park and Priory Park.

Your Arrival on Site

Train Station 2 miles. Bus stop 1 mile away in St Neots.

Brown sign at junction Berkley St / Barford Rd B1043. Brown Sign at Junction Hardwick Rd B1043. Brown sign at bottom of Hardwick Rd. Brown sign at Junction of St Marys St / Montague St B1043.

Barrier locked 11pm open 7am. Walk in gate always unlocked. When Barrier closed overnight parking is available in visitor parking area to left of entrance.

Approach road is tarmac leading to site. Parking for 7 vehicles overnight in visitor car park. Walk in access to side of entrance barrier.

Arrivals park in front of Reception / Amenity block. Clearly signed. Road surface is tarmac path.

There is no designated accessible parking. Handrail fitted on outside wall leading to reception door. There is a gradual slope on tarmac path. There is a small step into reception.



The reception is clearly signed. Opening hours are 9am to 10.30 and 4pm to 6pm.

For out of hours, there are signs on reception door. Emergency phone number clearly displayed on reception door and on site leaflet.

Surface leading to reception is tarmac path leading to reception with a step up from the road and has slight slope. Raised threshold into reception.

Clear floor space in reception.

No low level counter.

R Your Pitch

A car can be parked next to all pitches. Four hard standing pitches within 60 metres of the accessible facility.

Hardstanding pitches are gravel.



There are level hard standing and grass pitches close to road edge.

Travelling Around Site

All site roads are tarmac. There is a speed limit around the site of 5mph. A one-way system is in operation, and this is clearly signed.

Speed bumps on site. There is lighting around facilities block and reception.

No reception car park. We can park seven vehicles in overnight car park, which is used in the daytime for visitors.



The Facility Block

Grass and roads are uneven some slab path to tarmac path around blocks.

There is a slight slope to both blocks.

One route has a step on tarmac paths mostly level with slope leading to the accessible.

All other doors have step into entrance. There are no semi-ambulant cubicles. All taps are push button.

Stools in showers wall mounted (90kg max weight). Showers are dial and push button.

There is lighting around both blocks at night.

The Accessible Facilities

Flat tarmac path around facility blocks slight slope up to accessible entrance.

Hand rails on wall to the right of entrance where slope starts and finishes at door.

Slight step over threshold as you enter the room.

Toilet has one fixed handrail on the left and one drop down on the right. There is a handrail to the right of the sink.



There is transfer space on the right sides of the toilet if seated. Washbasin can be reached from the toilet.

Press button taps.

There is a hand dryer. There is one high mirror and one lower level. With stool beside.

Shower has one wall mounted handrail and one drop down. Shower has a single lever mixer, is open access and has a height adjustable shower head. Shower seat limit is 90kg There is a handrail inside the door.

Floor is non-slip.

There is hair dryer. There is an emergency cord that can be reached from the floor.

The alarm cannot be heard from the staff pitches. The alarm can be heard from the outside of reception. It cannot be heard inside reception.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

Slight slope then level surface with step into these areas. Surface leading to these areas is tarmac path.

Taps are press button.

Sloping path up to laundry door with small step. Washing machine and Tumble dryer is floor level and front loading.

There is a wall mounted iron and mounted ironing board .

There are covered washing up facilities. Taps are push button.

There is an outdoor drying area.



There is no indoor recreation area, There is no children's play area.





Access to the refuse area is uneven.

The path leading to these areas is gravel leading to slabs. No steps or kerbs. No handrails.

Full sized commercial bins 1.2m. There is a fire bell on each water point.

There is unrestricted access over grass to all water points.

Fire assembly points are in the carpark and riverside facilities block.

Assembly point surfaces are Car park gravel, Amenity block grass.
