About Tregurrian

The site is situated on the headland between the beautiful bays of Mawgan Porth and Watergate Bay.

The beach at Watergate Bay can be accessed via the Southwest coastal path in approximately 15 - 20 minutes, this is generally easy to negotiate but it is steep in places with steps and so not suitable for ambulatory devices or push chairs.



The local bus service, however, stops in Tregurrian village, (a short gently sloping 250m walk from site). This goes to and from Watergate Bay, Mawgan Porth, Newquay and Padstow. The service stops at ~ 5:00pm.

In both Watergate Bay and Mawgan Porth there are carparks which are Motorhome accessible.

Newquay is a short 10-minute drive away to most of the major supermarkets again generally with reasonable access for Motorhomes.

Your Arrival on Site

The site is best accessed via the airport road, (turn left at the T-junction after the airport entrance) not from Newquay along the coast road. The nearest train station is 4 miles from site. The nearest bus stop is 250m from site.

The site is on a single-track road just after the Watergate Bay Touring Park. There is a triangular, blind junction before Tregurrian village which has a sign directing you to the access lane.

The site is on two different sides of the lane. On arrival head to the side with the stand-alone Welcome sign and large reception building, there is a white line on the floor and stop sign indicating where to pull up. It is level tarmac.

There are two keypad operated barriers that are automatic on exit, locked between 11pm and 7am.

Instructions are on the door for arrivals after 8pm.

The approach surface is tarmac.

There is overnight parking outside reception for one late arrival.

The reception car park will hold three cars.

There is no dedicated accessible parking.

There are no handrails.

There are no steps or steep inclines.

There are plant tubs outside reception.





Opening hours are 9:00 - 10:30am & 5:00 - 6:00pm.

For out of hours please follow instructions shown on door to find team when reception is closed. After 6pm and before 8pm, the team can be reached via a mobile phone, the number is displayed on the reception door.

After 8pm there is an emergency mobile number to ring to alert team for blue light emergencies only.

There is level access leading into reception.

There are no access issues when entering reception.

The floor space is clear from clutter.



Cars can be parked next to pitches on site.

There are hardstanding pitches close to an accessible facility. These pitches are gravel.

There are level pitches that are close to facility blocks.



There are 2 speedbumps on the site roads.

There are lighting bollards throughout site.

Approaches to facilities blocks lit.

The reception has wall lights.

The Facility Block

There is a clear, well-maintained path leading to the facilities.

There are no steps or ramps.

There is level access when entering the block.



There are no semi-ambulant cubicles.

Taps are screw top and push button.

Showers are push button operated.

There are no steps into the showers.

The facility block is lit at night.

L The Accessible Facilities

There is a flat level path leading to the accessible facility.

There are no handrails leading to the accessible facility.

There is flat level access when entering the room.

The toilet has handrails.

The toilet has a large flush handle.

There is a transfer space to the right of the toilet.

The washbasin can be reached from the toilet.

Taps are lever top.

There is a hand dryer.

There is a mirror, it is not full length.

The shower has handrails.

The shower is dial operated.

The shower is open access.

The shower head is height adjustable.

The floor is non-slip.

There is no hair dryer.

There is an emergency cord that can be reached from the floor.



The alarm can be heard from the staff pitches or reception.

Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

This area has good level access.

A paved path leads to this area.

Taps are push top

The washing machine is front loading and floor level.

The tumble dryer is front loading, it is situated on top above the washing machine.

There is a wall mounted iron.

There is a freestanding ironing board.

There are indoor washing up facilities.

Taps are push top.

There is an outdoor drying area.



There is no indoor recreation area.

There is no children's play area.

There is no dog walk on site.

Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There is flat level access leading to the refuse area from the Atlantic side of the site. From the Bay side pitches there is a short fairly steep ramp, which may not be suitable for some ambulatory devices, however the barrier can also be opened to enable access if required.

Access is over tarmac areas.

There are no steps, kerbs, or handrails.



The bins are approx. 1.2m high.

There are fire bells on site.

There is unrestricted access to firefighting equipment.

The fire assembly points are outside reception block (Atlantic side) and next to the bin compound on the Bay side of the site

The assembly point surfaces are tarmac.
