About Winchcombe

Set within the heart of the Cotswold countryside, Winchcombe campsite is a tranquil site and a place to sit back, relax, unwind and get back to nature.

With 61 Touring pitches, a mixture of both hardstanding and grass, although hardstanding pitches are level, grass pitches vary and, on some, levelling blocks may be required.



This Site also offers options of both Seasonal and Storage pitches, and an exclusive, private, 10 pitch Luxury Lodge Park where it offers Holiday Home Ownership.

With a Lake forming the heart of this camp site, campers can both enjoy both wildlife and fishing (an Environment Agency Rod License is required to fish).

This site accepts all camping unit types and offers modern toilet and shower facilities to help make for a stress-free camping experience.

The Site also boasts a Recreation Room, Laundry, Information Room and enclosed Play Area.

Dog walkers are spoilt for choice, both with a small, shaded woodland Orchard and with an open meadow 10 Acre field.

Known as the 'walking capital of the Cotswolds', Winchcombe's position on the Cotswold's way and the Winchcombe way, makes it popular with walkers and historians alike. Easy walks to local pubs are available and are dog friendly.

National Cycle Route 41 is also close to the Campsite.



Your Arrival on Site

Train station (Ashchurch) 6 miles from site.

Bus stop in Alderton Village (Marchants buses only) limited service.

There are two brown signs on the B4077, one large site sign on entrance.

One keypad operated barrier that is automatic on exit. It's locked between 11pm and 7am.

Overnight parking is available just inside the main entrance.

Tarmac leading to loose gravel. The visitor parking is in a Car Park located just inside the main gate and approx. 10m from Reception.

New arrivals should pull up into the arrivals bay, parallel to the reception building. The surface is tarmac and is reasonably level.

There are no designated spaces but plenty of spaces a short, level distance from the reception.

There is no handrail attached to the reception wall. No steps but a gentle incline. Potted plants along the path.





Your Check In

The reception is clearly signed for arrivals. Pitches are available from 1pm.

Reception/Shop opening times are 9am-10:30am then 4pm -6pm. Access is over level concrete slabs.

Slight lip on the door.

Good clear floor space in reception. No low-level reception counter, but clipboards are available.



Your Pitch

Cars can be parked next to most pitches on site.

Four pitches close to the accessible room. Loose gravel on three, grass pitch on one.

Many level hardstanding and grass pitches are close to the site road.



Travelling Around Site

All site roads are tarmac. There is a speed limit around the site of 5mph. A one-way system is in operation, and this is clearly signed.

At night there is low level lighting on the outside of all blocks and the rest of the site is dimly lit by hook-up bollards.



The Facility Block

There is a clear, well-maintained path leading to the facilities.

There are two small steps up to the female facilities. It is level to the male, family, and accessible room.

Some sinks have lever taps.

There are stools in all showers, the showers are operated by a push button in men's and ladies and a dial in the family room.

The showers have level access.

The facility block has both vanity lights above the mirrors and ceiling lights.





The Accessible Facilities

There is a flat level concrete slab path leading to the accessible facility.

There is flat level access into the accessible facility.

There are handrails next to the toilet, a larger flush handle and transfer space to the left of the toilet.

The wash basin cannot be reached from the toilet and has larger than normal lever top taps.

There is a hand dryer located in the room. There is a low-level mirror above the sink and one at full height.

The shower has a handrail and drop-down seat, is dial operated with a height adjustable shower head and open access.

The floor is nonslip.

There is an emergency chord next to the toilet and in the shower. Both can be reached from the floor; the emergency alarm can be heard from both staff pitches and reception.

The accessible room can be accessed with a RADAR key.



Laundry & Food Preparation Areas

The laundry and food preparation areas both have level access.

The approach path is concrete, the taps are screw top.

The washing machine is front loading and can be reached from the floor.

The tumble dryers are front loading and cannot be reached from the floor.

There is a wall mounted iron. There are outdoor washing up facilities available.

All washing up sinks has screw top taps. There is an outdoor drying area with one rota dryer.



Recreational Areas

There is an indoor recreation area. There is a ramp leading to this area. There are no steps leading to the indoor recreational area.

There are freestanding chairs. There is an outdoor children's play area.



This is accessible over grass with no designated path. There is a single bench overlooking the play area. The play area has a rubberised surface with raise edges surrounding it. This entire area is fenced in.



Waste, Water, Fire and Evacuation

There are no steps of kerbs restricting access to the refuse areas.

There is a fence surrounding the compound. All bins on site are full height industrial 1100L units 1.2m high.

There is a fire triangle located at all water points which has ramped as well as unrestricted access over tarmac. The firefighting equipment is accessed over grass and/or tarmac.

The assembly points are by the playground (Grass Area) and the Visitor Car Park (Tarmac).

Campers are briefed about the assembly point on arrival.
