

Access Statement – Adgestone

Your Arrival on Site

- Train station is 1 mile from site. Bus stop is approx. 1.5 miles
- There are two brown signs on the Fairway, one large site sign on entrance
- One site barrier that is locked between 11pm and 7am
- Limited overnight parking is available just inside the main site gate
- Main entrance is tarmac leading to loose gravel or grass
- The visitors parking doubles as the overnight parking
- New arrivals should pull up to reception. The surface is tarmac with a gentle incline
- There are potted plants along the path

Your Check in

- The reception is clearly signed for arrivals
- It is open 9am-10:30am & 4pm-5.30pm
- There is a bell located on the reception door which is connected to an on duty team member until 8.00pm
- There is good clear floor space in reception
- No low level reception counter, but clipboards are available

Your Pitch

- Cars can be parked next to all pitches on site
- At least four pitches and two Ready Camp tents are close to the accessible shower room and toilet
- Many fairly level grass pitches are close to the site road

Your Facilities

- There is a clear, well maintained path leading to the facilities
- There is a gentle ramp leading in to the blocks
- There is level access to ladies, gents, family and Accessible room
- There are fold down seats in all showers
- The showers are operated by a dial in men's and ladies and a dial in the family room
- The showers have a step in
- The facility block has low level, wall mounted lights

Your Accessible Facilities

- There is a flat level concrete slab path leading to the accessible facility
- There is flat level access in to the accessible facility
- There are handrails next to the toilet
- There is a regular size flush handle
- There is transfer space to the left of the toilet
- The wash basin cannot be reached from the toilet
- There is a hand dryer located in the room
- There is a low level mirror above the sink that does not extend to full height
- The shower has a number of handrails
- The shower is dial operated
- The shower is open access, not a cubicle
- The shower head is height adjustable
- The floor is nonslip
- There is a hair dryer
- There is an emergency chord next to the toilet and in the shower. Both can be reached from the floor
- The emergency alarm cannot be heard from staff pitches or reception

Your Laundry and Food Preparation Areas

- The laundry and food preparation areas both have level access
- The approach path is concrete
- The taps are screw top
- The washing machines are top loading and can be reached from the floor
- The tumble dryers are front loading and can be reached from the floor
- There is a wall mounted iron
- There is a freestanding ironing board
- There are washing up facilities available
- All washing up sinks have screw top taps
- There is an outdoor drying area with three rota dryers
- There are no low level sink in the washing up area

Your Recreational Areas

- There is no indoor recreational area
- There is a covered area for playing table tennis
- There is a swimming pool on site with level paved access
- There is a café on site with concrete level access

Waste, Fire and Evacuation

- There are no steps of kerbs restricting access to the refuse area
- All bins on site are full height industrial 1100L units, approx. 1.2m high
- There is a fire triangle located at all water points which has unrestricted access over grass
- The firefighting equipment is accessed over grass
- The assembly points are located in the main car park which is tarmac and the other is in the far camping field which is grass
- Campers are briefed about the assembly points on arrival. There are clear signs

Miscellaneous Information

- There are speed bumps along the main site road
- At night there is low level lighting on the outside of all blocks and the rest of the site is dimly lit by hook-up bollards
- The main reception car park can hold at least eight cars
- The overnight carpark can hold at least six cars
- There are a small number of benches dotted around the site

Ready Camp Units

- There is one car parking space next to each unit. Other cars must be parked next to reception
- There are no designated paths leading to the units, access is all over grass
- All units have two steps up
