

Access Statement – Sheriff Hutton

Your Arrival on Site

- Train station is 9 miles away at York.
- Bus stops Sheriff Hutton 1 mile and West Lilling 0.75miles
- There is one brown sign on opposite side of road to site, and one large club sign outside the main entrance
- The approach to site is via B roads but with good access
- There is a long drive into the site which houses a layby on the right hand side for overnight parking and visitor parking
- At the end of this drive is a white gate which is locked between the hours of 11.00pm and 7.00am unless access is needed in an emergency
- All roads on site are tarmac, speed bumps are situated at various points around site and a 5 mph speed limit is in force
- Entrance onto the main site is via an electronic barrier operated by a key pad
- Access code will be given when checking in
- New arrival should pull up outside reception which is clearly signed

Your Check in

- The reception is clearly signed for arrivals
- If for any reason reception is closed then instructions are placed on view on office door
- The approach surface to reception is paving slabs; there are no steps but a very slight incline then levels off
- Once inside covered area there are tiles and a carpet in front of office door
- Slight lip on the door
- Good clear floor space in reception
- There are two levels to the counter top, one being at low level

Your Pitch

- The Site offers a mixture of pitch types to suit your needs
- Hard standings with electric, grass with electric and grass only
- Two Ready camp tents
- Majority of pitches are level and are close to the road on site
- Cars can be parked at side of unit
- Only one car per pitch
- As a fire precaution units have to be 6 metres away from adjacent units

Your Facilities

- There is one toilet block on site
- There is a clear well maintained path, first part paving slabs, second part is tarmac
- There are no steps; tarmac access goes all way round the toilet block
- Ladies is on the left side of block
- Gents is on the right side of block
- There are four showers in both ladies and gents all operated by push button
- There is a wall mounted seat in the drying area
- There are two privacy cubicles in both Ladies and gents with push button taps
- All sinks have small mirrors over them and a small strip light
- There are 6 toilets in each, one with grab rails on both sides with a door that opens outwards
- There are 2 hand dryers in both ladies and gents
- There are two coin operated hair dryers in ladies
- At the far end is the Parent & Child room comprising of a toilet, sink with a lever tap and a controllable dial shower
- It contains a wall mounted baby changing station and at the side of sink a wall mounted child chair

Your Accessible Facilities

- The accessible facility is round the corner from reception
- The approach to the accessible is paving slab with a slight incline then levelling off
- There is level access into the accessible
- There is a toilet with 2 grab rails one fixed and one which folds up or down
- The sink cannot be reached from the toilet
- The sink is at low level with a lever tap
- A mirror is above the sink this is not a full mirror
- At the side of the sink are 2 wall mounted fixed grab rails
- There is a shower which is operated with a dial control with a small lever at the bottom and is height adjustable
- The shower area has a wall mounted folding seat with two wall mounted folding arms, one doubling up for the drying area folding seat
- There are 2 emergency pull cords, one at side of toilet and one in between shower and drying area, both can be reached from floor level
- All lighting in facilities is controlled by sensors, no light switches

Your Laundry and Food Preparation Areas

- On approaching the toilet block the front has 2 dish washing areas, with 3 sinks in each one being low level with push button taps. The other two twist taps
- In between the dish washing is a small passage this goes to the Elsan, chemical disposal point which has one step to gain access
- Once inside there is a sink with a push button tap and a wall mounted hand dryer
- At the far end is also the laundry which houses a front loading washing machine and a front loading tumble dryer, both coin operated
- There are two sinks both with push taps
- Outside to the rear are two rotary dryers

Your Recreational Areas

- There is an outdoor play area accessible over grass, no defined path
- There is a single bench which overlooks the play area

Waste, Fire and Evacuation

- There is a short slab stone path with a slight incline up to bin area
- All bins are full industrial height
- There are fire triangles located on all water points with instructions of procedure in the event of a fire
- All water points have a stone slab path leading up to them
- Fire extinguishers are on the front of all water point entrances
- There are 2 assembly points in case of fire
 - 1) Opposite reception
 - 2) In layby on drive way into the site
- All fire points are clearly signed

Miscellaneous Information

- The motor home service point is located in a large layby just above toilet block
- There is a water filling bollard
- A drive over waste disposal and a lift up drain cover for black waste

Ready Camp

- There is one car parking space next to each unit. Other cars must be parked opposite reception
- There are no designated paths leading to the units, access is all over grass
- Both units have a single step up
