

Access Statement – Slingsby

Your Arrival on Site

- Arriving at the site is via a wide entrance leading up to the reception from the main street of the village
- Ground is level for arrivals leading to reception
- Tarmac roads service all parts of the site and a one way system is in place
- Between 11.00pm and 7.00am gates are locked for security and vehicle movement is prohibited on site
- Parking is provided for those returning after 11.00pm. This is located outside the site barriers

Your Check in

- Access to reception is all on one level from the waiting area
- Reception is clearly signed
- There is good clear floor space inside
- The office opening hours are 9am until 10am and 4pm until 5pm later in the high season
- In case of an emergency there is a telephone number on the reception door to ring

Your Pitch

- The site offers a mixture of grass and hard standing pitches and all pitches have electric hook-ups These pitches are all relatively level
- Cars can be pitched next to their unit
- All customers are given a choice of pitches and shown to a pitch and explained where the site facilities are
- Assistance with pitching will be offered if needed

Your Facilities

- There is a clear, well maintained path leading to the facilities
- There is a gentle ramp leading in to the blocks
- Access is over concrete slabs
- There is one semi-ambulant cubicle in both men's and ladies
- All sinks have Lever taps throughout
- There are fold down seats in all showers
- The showers are operated by a push button in men's and ladies and a dial in the accessible room
- The showers have a step down
- The facility block has low level, wall mounted lights

Your Accessible Facilities

- There is a flat level concrete slab path leading to the accessible facility.
- There are handrails leading to the accessible facility. As you approach the right rail is wall mounted and the left is free standing
- There is flat level access in to the accessible facility
- There are handrails next to the toilet
- There is a regular size flush handle
- There is transfer space to the left of the toilet
- The wash basin cannot be reached from the toilet
- The washbasin has larger than normal lever top taps
- There is a hand dryer located in the room
- There is a low level mirror above the sink that does not extend to full height
- The shower has a number of handrails
- The shower is dial operated
- The shower is open access, not a cubicle
- The shower head is height adjustable
- The floor is nonslip
- There is a hair dryer
- There is an emergency chord next to the toilet and in the shower. Both can be reached from the floor
- The emergency alarm can be heard from both staff pitches and also reception
- The accessible room can be accessed with a RADAR key

Your Laundry and Food Preparation Areas

- The laundry and food preparation areas both have level access
- The approach path is concrete
- The taps are screw top
- The washing machine is front loading and can be reached from the floor
- The tumble dryers are top loading and can be reached from the floor
- There is a wall mounted iron
- There is a freestanding iron
- There are both indoor and outdoor washing up facilities available
- All washing up sinks have screw top taps
- There is an outdoor drying area with three rota dryers
- There is one low level sink in both the indoor and outdoor washing up area

Your Recreational Areas

- There is an indoor recreation area
- There is a slight ramp leading to this area
- There are no steps leading to the indoor recreational area
- There is a variety of seating available such as sofas and freestanding chairs
- There is an outdoor children play area
- This is accessible over grass with no designated path
- There is a single bench overlooking the play area
- The play area has a bark surface with raised edges surrounding it to keep the bark in place
- This entire area is mostly fenced in

Waste, Fire and Evacuation

- There is a short, steep concrete ramp leading up to all refuse areas
- There are no steps or kerbs restricting access to the refuse areas
- There is a waist high fence either side of the entrance ramp which may be used as a handrail and a fence surrounding the compound
- All bins on site are full height industrial 1100L units
- There is a fire triangle located at all water points which has unrestricted access over grass.
- The firefighting equipment is accessed over grass
- The assembly points are located in the main car park which is loose gravel and the other is in the far camping field which is grass
- Campers are briefed about the assembly point on arrival. There are clear signs.

Miscellaneous Information

- There are speed bump along the main site road
- At night there is low level lighting on the outside of all blocks and the rest of the site is dimly lit by hook-up bollards
- The main reception car par can hold at least eight cars
- The overnight carpark can hold at least six cars
- There are a small number of benches dotted around the site
