Your Arrival on Site

- o The Nearest train station is Borough Green which is 4 miles
- The nearest bus stop is ½ mile from site on the main A25, it is a reasonably level walk along a tarmac country lane, but there is no pavement and no street lights
- \circ $\;$ There are large brown signs on the A25 that gives direction to the site
- We have a chain system to the entrance to the site which campers remove and replace
- o Out of hours arrivals are clearly displayed on the reception door
- \circ $\;$ The approach to the site is via a narrow lane with passing areas
- We have a small car park which will hold 5 cars and 1 motorhome/camper
- When arriving on to site new arrivals should pull into the layby opposite the reception which is sloping tarmac
- No designated accessible parking
- No handrails to office
- The reception is accessed two ways one via two steps and the second is via gentle slope leading to reception
- The office is very small and has a step leading into the office
- Clipboards are available

Your Check in

- The reception is clearly signed
- Opening hours are 9:00am-10:30am 16:00pm-18:00hrs
- \circ $\;$ Follow the instructions on the reception door
- There is level access leading to the reception
- There is one step on entry
- The floor space is free from clutter

<u>Your Pitch</u>

- Cars can be parked next to units on all pitches
- No hardstanding's on site
- All pitches are sloping
- We have pitches near facilities
- o All vehicles and units must be faced downhill

Your Facilities

- There is a clear well maintained path leading to the facilities
- \circ $\;$ There are two toilet blocks at the top of 14 steps $\;$
- There is a step on the entry into all facilities
- There are no semi-ambulant cubicles
- Screw type taps
- \circ We have stools in all showering areas which are clearly marked with the weight limit
- Lever type and push button showers
- Showers have a step
- Facility block is well lit at night

Your Accessible Facilities

- Slight Slope that is paved leads to the facility
- There are no handrails
- Level access but slight slope leading to facilities
- Toilet has handrails
- Toilet has a larger flush handle
- Transfer space to the left
- Washbasin cannot be reached from the toilet
- Taps are lever type
- No hand dryer. Paper towel dispenser
- Two mirrors one high and one low
- The shower has handrails
- Shower is lever operated
- Shower is open access
- Shower head is height adjustable
- Floor is non-slip
- There is no hair dryer
- Emergency cords can be reached from the floor
- They can be heard from the staff pitches and reception
- \circ The accessible room door is key operated which is available from reception

Your Laundry, Food Preparation Areas and CDP

- Adjacent to the main facilities and has a step up to both areas.
- Approach surface is slabs
- o Screw taps
- Washing machines are front loading, they are floor level
- Tumble dryers are front loading and stacked
- There is a wall mounted iron
- There is a free standing ironing board
- There are indoor washing up facilities with screw top taps
- There is an outdoor drying area
- Access to these facilities is difficult

Your Recreational Areas

- There is no indoor recreation area
- There is an outdoor children's play area
- Access leading to it is level
- Picnic benches are available near the area
- Play area surface is bark
- There is a raised edge surrounding the play area

Waste, Fire and Evacuation

- There is flat level access to the refuse area
- Path is slabs
- There are no steps or kerbs
- There are no handrails
- All bins are full height industrial 1100L units. 1.2m high
- There is a fire triangle on site
- There is unrestricted access to firefighting equipment
- Fire assembly point one main entrance car park
- Fire point Two is at the side of the play area
- Assembly point surfaces are level grass

Miscellaneous Information

- There are no speed bumps on site
- Several pitches have the small led lights from the bollards and both the facilities and reception are well lit
- There is no reception carpark
- Overnight carpark will hold five cars
