

Access Statement – Skye

Your Arrival on Site

- Train station is 48 miles from site. Request bus stop at top of drive
- There are green signs 200m either side of the site entrance
- There is one manual barrier which is locked between 23.00 – 07.00 hrs. Overnight parking is available just outside the barrier
- Approach is tarmac leading to compacted gravel
- Visitor parking is outside the barrier, in the same area as overnight parking
- New arrivals are invited to park through the barrier, adjacent to reception, on a level, compacted gravel surface
- There are no designated accessible parking spaces but there is plenty of space a short, level distance from reception
- There are no handrails leading to reception
- There are no steps as the entrance is level

Your Check in

- The reception is clearly marked for arrival.
- Reception opening hours are 09.00 – 10.00 & 16.00 – 18.00. Arrivals are from 13.00 – 20.00
- There is a bell on the reception door which is connected to an on-duty member of staff
- The reception has a level floor throughout
- The reception door has a slight lip (less than 1cm) on the leading edge
- The reception has an open, uncluttered floor space
- There is no low level reception counter. Clip boards are available

Your Pitch

- Cars can be parked on or next to most pitches on the site
- There are five pitches close to the accessible room
- All pitches are level and have a gravel surface
- The facilities block is central to the camp site
- Some of the grass pitches are sloped

Your Facilities

- The facilities block is surrounded by a path made of paving slabs
- On one side only there are four steps leading to the facilities block. All other approaches are level
- One semi-ambulant cubicle in both the Gents & Ladies
- All taps are push button
- The Gents & Ladies each has a cubicle with a wall-hung seat
- Showers are all push-button operated. Water temperature cannot be adjusted
- The facilities block has a level floor surface throughout
- There is sensor lighting around the facilities block at night

Your Accessible Facilities

- A flat path made of paving slabs surrounds the facilities block
- There are no handrails leading to the facilities building
- There is level access to the facilities block
- The toilet has one drop down rail to the left and one wall mounted rail to the right
- The toilet has a push button flush
- There is space to the left of the toilet
- Depending on the individual, it may be possible to reach the wash basin from the toilet
- The wash basin taps are lever operated
- There is a paper towel dispenser for drying hands
- There are two mirrors, one of which is full length
- The shower has four wall mounted hand rails
- The shower is dial operated
- The shower is open access
- The shower head is height adjustable
- The floor is non-slip
- There is no hand dryer
- Yes, there is an emergency cord
- Yes, the emergency chord can be reached from the floor
- The alarm cannot be heard from the site team pitches
- The alarm cannot be heard from reception
- There are low level hooks for coats etc.

Your Recreational Areas

- There is good level access but the turning circle is limited
- Gravel leading to the paving slab path around the facilities block.
- The taps have screw type tops
- The washing machines are front loading
- Two machines can be loaded from the floor
- The tumble dryers are front loading
- One tumble dryer is stacked
- There is an iron
- The iron is wall mounted
- There is an ironing board
- The ironing board is free standing
- There are washing up facilities
- The washing up facilities are indoor
- The sinks have screw type tops
- There is an external washing line
- In the washing up room, there are two low level sinks and two higher level sinks. There are also hooks for coats

Your Recreational Areas

- There is no indoor recreation area
- There is no children's outdoor play area

Waste, Fire and Evacuation

- There is a slight slope made of gravel, leading to the refuse area
- There are no steps, curbs or handrails leading to the refuse area
- The refuse bins are waist height
- There is a fire triangle on site
- There is unrestricted access to firefighting equipment on site
- There is one assembly point located in the overnight parking area
- The assembly point area has a mixture of grass and gravel

Miscellaneous Information

- There are no speed bumps on the park
- The facilities block is lit by sensor lights
- There are also sensor lights on the general site
- The reception area has no space for overnight parking
- The overnight parking area could hold up to three cars

Camping Pods

- There are two steps up to each pod
- The Pods are located on grass
- There is no defined path leading to the pods
