



## Hayfield Club Site – Kinderlow End

Camping and Caravanning



### Route Summary



This walk from Hayfield Club Site takes you to Kinderlow End on the edge of the Kinder plateau with magnificent views in all directions. The walk also features moorland and meadows. Points Of Interest: A protected medieval cross. Fascinating rock formations.

### Description



**A three-hour walk from the Hayfield Club Site on lanes, paths and tracks. One steep incline. Can be boggy in places.**

## 1. Start

Leave Hayfield Club Site and turn R.



In 200 metres pass toilets on the R and arrive at Bowden Bridge. Cross bridge and turn right along Kinder Road. Take the L fork towards Kinder Reservoir, go through gates towards reservoir.

## 2. 1.4km/0.9 miles

Just before the next gate turn R over a small bridge and ascend grassy/rocky path to lane that can be slippery when wet. Go straight across through gate, signposted Stoney Ford.





Follow track up grassy hill alongside Pinewood Forest on L.

### 3. 2km/1.3 miles

Turn R at public bridleway sign for 'Oaken Clough'. Ascend grassy slope, curve L at path junction, keeping remains of stone wall on left. Go through broken gate in broken wall and bear L to stay on path across open moor. At gate in wall signed 'Broad Clough', turn R along path, then follow the path with wall on R around corner to gate.



### 4. 3.7km/2.3 miles

Turn L and begin steep climb up Kinderlow End, with steps towards peak. Continue with ridge overlooking Kinder Reservoir on L to a paved path.



### 5. 4.8km/3 miles

Turn R at path junction.

Continue on obvious path after paving runs out, keeping wall on R down to a gate.

### 6. 5.5km/3.4 miles

Turn R on to Edale/Hayfield bridleway at Edale Cross. This is the location of the medieval cross.



### 7. 6km/3.7 miles

Turn R up bank at Stony Ford, ascending stone steps and following public footpath sign L for 'Hayfield via Tunstead Clough'.



Turn L at fork in path and follow down to wall-stile. Cross and continue over three fields and stiles until arriving at gate. Go over next stile taking diagonal path across field.

### 8. 7.7km/4.8 miles

Turn L through gate across field, through 'High Peak Estate' gate, cross field and over stile down stoney/grass path passing Tunstead House on R. Follow drive down to crossroads go straight over onto Edale Road. Follow Edale Road back to Bowden Bridge.

### 9. 9km/5.6 miles

Bear L at Bowden Bridge back to Hayfield Club Site.
