### Description



This is a 3 hour circular walk from the Holmsley Camping in the Forest site, on lanes, paths and tracks.



## 1. Start

From reception turn L along Tarmac drive passed facilities to gate at bottom left hand corner.



Through gate follow path downhill and turn R just after pump room building on L. Cross wooden bridge.

## 2. 0.22km/0.14 miles

Take R fork in path.



## 3. 0.37km/0.23 miles

Through clearing take path on L. Follow grassy path ahead keeping at edge of woodland on R.

## Choose your trail



Path bends to L through gap in trees to main path turn R.

### 4. 0.82km/0.51 miles

At fork in path, turn L keeping trees on R.



### 5. 1.5km/0.94 miles

Proceed ahead crossing stream.



### 6. 1.6km/1 mile

On little used grassy path head towards left corner of fence.



### 7. 2.0km/1.28 miles

Keeping barbed wire fence on right proceed ahead. At end of fence line on corner keep ahead to main path. Keeping rundown house on right.





### 8.2.5km/1.56 miles

Follow grassy path to main shingle path, turn R. At T junction with Lane turn L. Past Holmsley car park on R. Walk on path on L of lane. Turn L at rear of house with wooden roof onto wide shingle path (disused railway line)



At crossroads of remains of brick bridge turn R. Follow main path ahead towards Burley.

### 9. 4.2km/2.62 miles

At cross roads of paths (Burley car park) turn R towards Wilverley road.



Turn L alongside Wilverley road into Burley village.

### 10. 4.7km/2.93 miles

Take same road back out of Burley. Turn R at Highcroft B&B Sign (opposite School) Follow shingle path taking L fork (Moorhouse Hotel)

### 11. 5.3km/3.35 miles

Turn L at Goats Penn cottage.

## Choose your trail



By double garages take path L across grass.

**12. 5.8km/3.64 miles**

Take L fork in path at top of the hill.



Stay on path. At fork in path turn R. Cross shingle covered board walk.

**13. 6.5km/4.08 miles**

Turn L staying on wide shingle path (disused railway) back to wooden roof cottage on corner.



Return to the campsite from this point using earlier path.

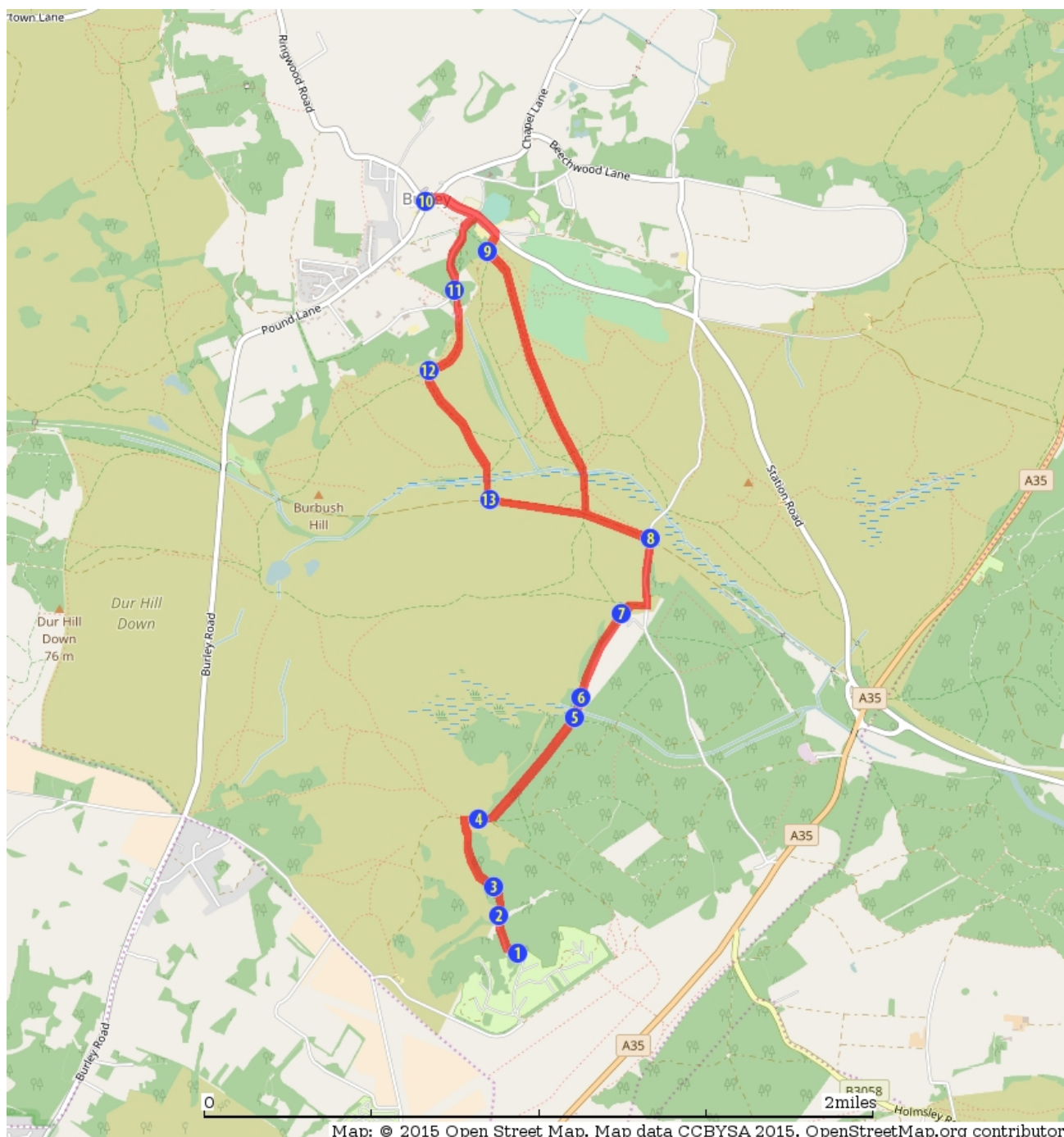
Turn R, walk on path on right of Lane. Past Holmsley car park on L. Turn R at T junction. Turn L on main shingle path to grassy path, keeping run down house on L. Take path to corner of fence, follow keeping barbed wire fence on L. At corner head towards little used grassy path. Cross stream keeping trees on L, turn R. At fork in path turn L to main path.

Through gap in trees follow R bend in path. Keeping edge of woodland on L, follow grassy path. Take path on R through clearing. Take L fork in path, cross wooden bridge.

Turn L, pump room on R, proceed to gate back into Holmsley Camping in the Forest site.
