Description



A SHORT WALK AROUND BROOMEY CROFT POOL AND CANAL POOL FROM KINGSBURY WATER PARK CLUB SITE



Walking by Broomey Croft Pool

Kingsbury Water Park is an exciting place to explore with lots of pools and lakes and a great path network linking them all. Walks can be made long or short to suit the party, but to get a real feel for what this area has to offer try this short walk from the Camping and Caravanning Club Site. For less than an hour's effort a nice circuit can be made around Broomey Croft Pool and along one bank of Canal Pool. Take your binoculars with you as there are plenty of birds to spot here, and in springtime there should be chicks to see too.

START: From the reception at the Club Site head out to the approach lane. Go left passing the campsite and a gate with 'Private' on it. Pass Ash Pool (right) and then a barrier to reach a car parking area by Broomey Croft Pool.

2 - Continue ahead to just before a gate (pictured above) and go right to pass through the car park. At the end of it pass a barrier and go left at a track junction to pass between Broomey Croft Pool and Cliff Pool South.

Pass through a kissing gate (which can be by-passed) to continue through woodland and reach a junction by a sign for 'Canal Pool'.

3 - Go left here to follow a path between Broomey Croft Pool and Canal Pool.

Continue between the pools to pass through a gate and reach a surfaced track.

Go left on the surfaced track. At the next junction by a 'Dogs Must Be On A Short Lead' sign go ahead to pass a bench. Follow the track and stay left when it forks after the bench. Continue to reach a gate and pass through a kissing gate next to it to reach a track junction. Take the track ahead which is wide and surfaced. At a barrier, curve left to continue on a track to reach a lane.

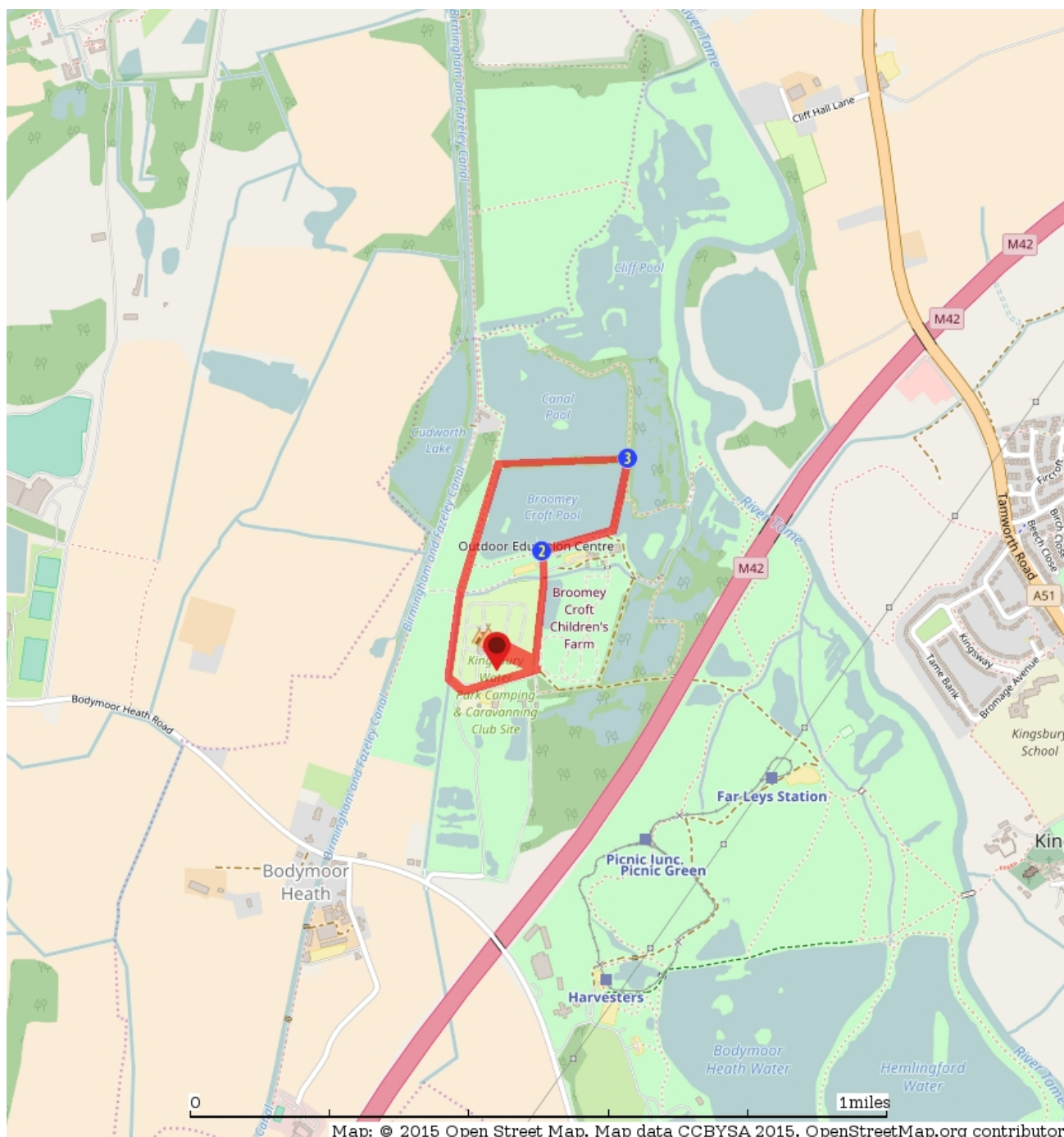
