## Description





This walk offers truly fantastic views over Loch Lomond and its many islands.

#### 1. START

For this walk follow The West Highland Way marker posts.



Leave Milarrochy Bay Club Site, cross the road and turn R.



Follow path parallel to road. The path crosses over road running alongside a pebble beach at the side of Loch Lomond.

### 2. 0.73km/0.45 miles

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Cross a wooden bridge and continue through a car park, passing Milarrochy Bay Visitor Centre on L. Continue on the forest trail directly ahead.



### 3. 2.74km/1.7 miles

Follow forest path crossing stream. Ascend on stone steps and continue on shingle forest path before descending on stone steps. Turn L on road.

Follow road and turn R at junction down tarmac footpath towards Balmaha.



#### 4. 2.9km/1.8 miles

Pass Tom Weir's statue on R.



Turn L at National Park Centre (opposite Oaktree Inn and Village Shop) into car park. Walk past the Loch Lomond

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Visitor Centre on R. Continue through to the back of the car park.

### 5. 3.2km/2 miles

At the Forestry Commission sign take the right hand path following The West Highland Way sign.



Continue on forest path through wooden gate and up steps. Follow West Highland Way sign turning left at gravel path T junction. Follow the West Highland Way path ascending Conic Hill.

#### 6. 4.8km/3 miles

To reach the summit of Conic Hill (a further 200 yards) you will have to leave the West Highland Way taking the path on R.



Return to Milarrochy Club Site using same route.
