Congratulations, Pennine – the first ever winner of the Trailer Tent class. By the smallest of

margins, admittedly – Pennine's 81% overall satisfaction rating outscored Camp-let's 79%. Pennine was the most popular make, accounting for nearly a third of all responses, followed by Camp-let (17%), Raclet (12%), Conway (9%) and Cabanon (7%).

Numbers were relatively low, reflecting the numbers sold in the UK, but the two most popular ranges were Pennine's Pathfinder series and Camp-let's Classics. There were also a number of responses for Pennine's Fiesta and Countryman models.

There have been changes of direction for both manufacturers in recent years. UK manufacturer Pennine was in danger of disappearing altogether but is now having a resurgence under new owners. Camp-let, meanwhile, is now a sister to fellow Danish manufacturer Isabella, best known throughout Europe for its caravan awnings (and, indeed, a long-term supplier of canvas to the Camp-let product).
