This is one of our largest sites, set in 22 hectares of gorgeous oak woodland and bordered by exquisite heathland. The campsite offers direct access to the forest via its numerous walking and cycling paths.

It's a family-friendly campsite and popular with groups of all ages. There is no electricity, but there are three toilet and shower blocks, disabled facilities, baby wash and changing areas and a dog shower.

Next door to the site you'll find the idyllic picnic site at Balmer Lawn. Sat on the Lymington River, it's a popular choice for both visitors and residents alike. And just a ten-minute stroll away is Brockenhurst village where a range of pubs, cafés, shops and restaurants provide all the essentials you need.

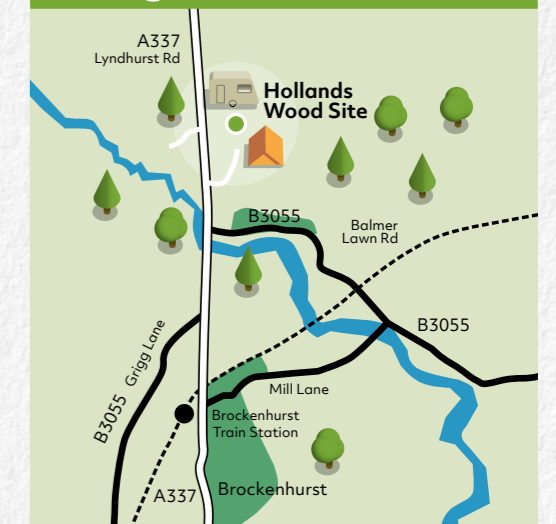

Setthorns is ideally located for walkers and cyclists, with many routes going directly from the site.

Open all year round, Setthorns can be enjoyed throughout the seasons, from the golden hues of autumn through to the warmth of the summer months.

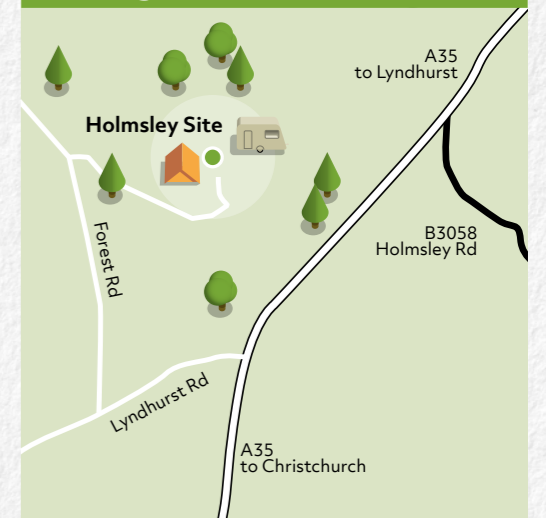

Roundhill

Revel in the freedom of the wide open green spaces. This heathland site sits on the southern edge of the National Park and is bordered by glorious green woodlands.

The spacious nature of the site makes it perfect for couples and families and those who want plenty of grassy areas for the young ones to play. There is easy access to a network of cycle paths that run throughout the forest and fishing is available at nearby Hatchet Pond.

Although there is no electricity on the site, there are toilet and shower blocks as well as washing-up facilities. A dog shower and baby changing facility are also available. Larger organised groups can be accommodated on the separate rally field that can cater for up to 60 pitches.

Bordered by Blackwater Stream and Ober Water, this idyllic site is right in the midst of nature and offers a close view of free roaming ponies, cattle and donkeys.

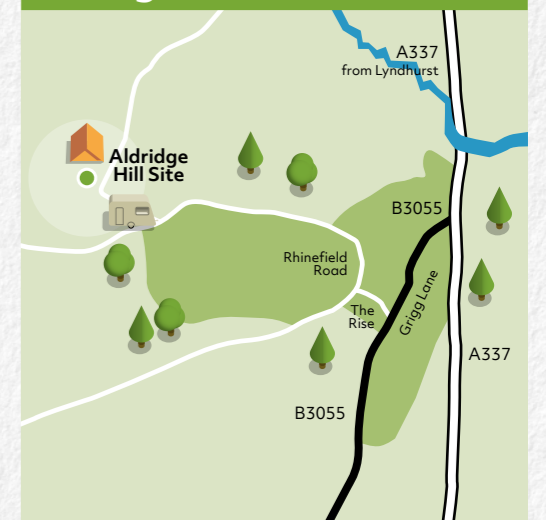
Explore the many tranquil cycle paths during the day, or soak up breath-taking sunsets and enjoy stargazing as night falls.

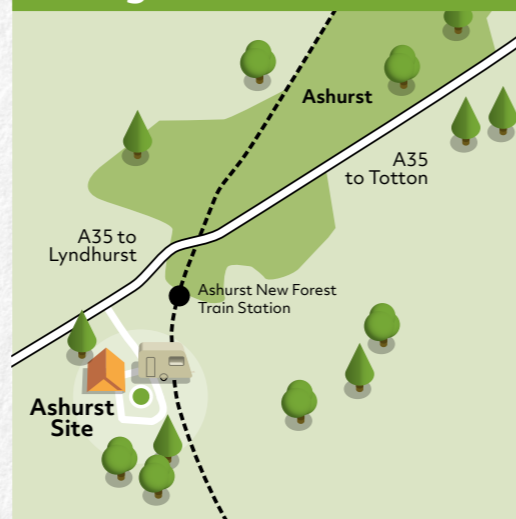
Ashurst and Lyndhurst villages are nearby, as well as a train station with direct trains to London and Bournemouth.

Sitting in a perfectly secluded spot of the New Forest, England's largest ancient woodland, is Denny Wood campsite.

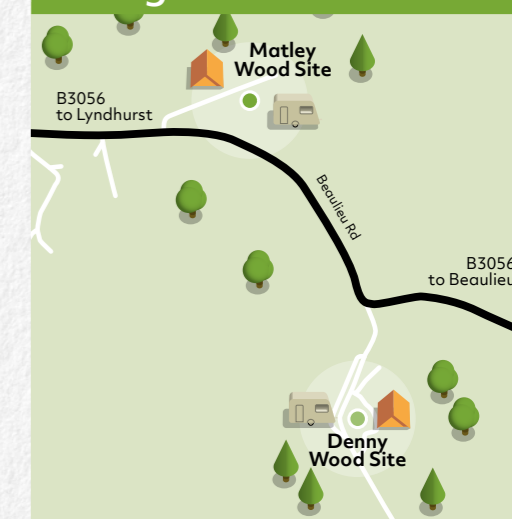
A haven for nature lovers and a peaceful retreat for holidaymakers, Denny Wood absorbs life's worries and replaces them with only the best feelings.

Ocknell campsite is located in a quiet expanse of heathland in the northern part of the New Forest and offers good hardstanding pitches and shelter.

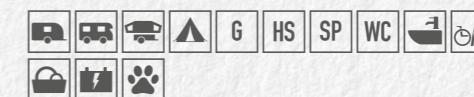
Paths take off in all directions, weaving through the site and in and out of the trees, creating an almost secret garden-like feel to the site.

Longbeech is surrounded by beautiful open clearings overlooked by ancient beechwood and is often visited by New Forest ponies and deer.

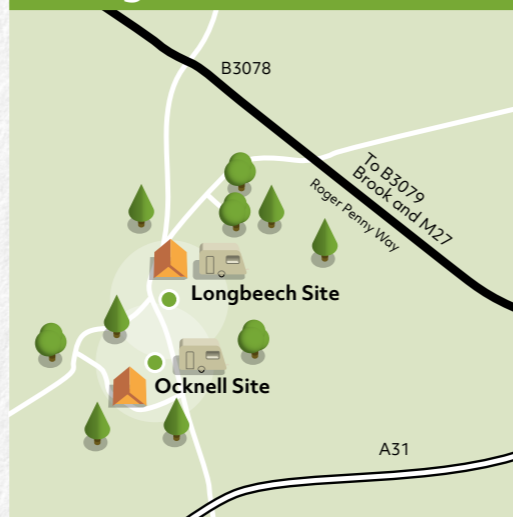
Hugged by grand and ancient trees that stand proudly throughout the site, Longbeech campsite delivers the feeling of complete isolation from the outside world.

Postern Hill is situated within the stunning SSSI-designated Savernake Forest, a perfect site for a 'get away from it all' break and ideal for walking, cycling and exploring the forest's diverse flora and fauna.

Full of oak, beech and sweet chestnut trees, the forest boasts the largest beech avenue in Britain, which was planned by Capability Brown.

A choice of supermarkets are just a stroll away, and walking a little further will take you into the picturesque market town of Marlborough, which offers a range of shops, restaurants and pubs.

Please note: There is a toilet block, but no showers; however there is a leisure centre just 1.5 miles away that provides showers at a reasonable price for campers.

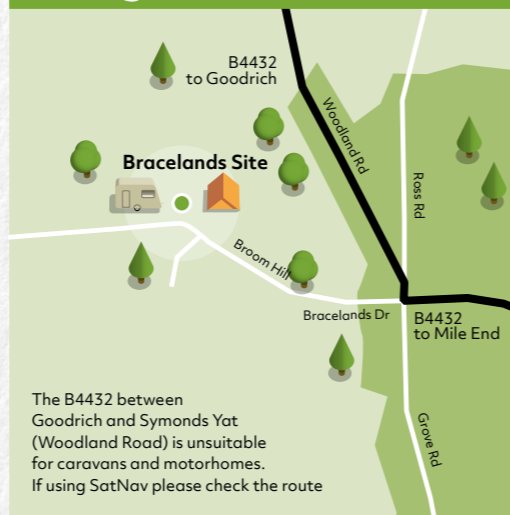

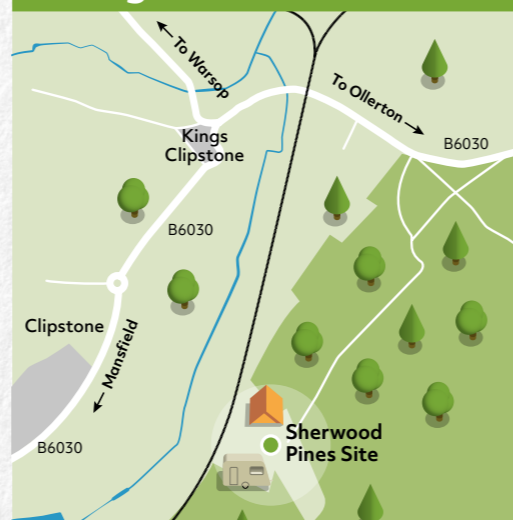

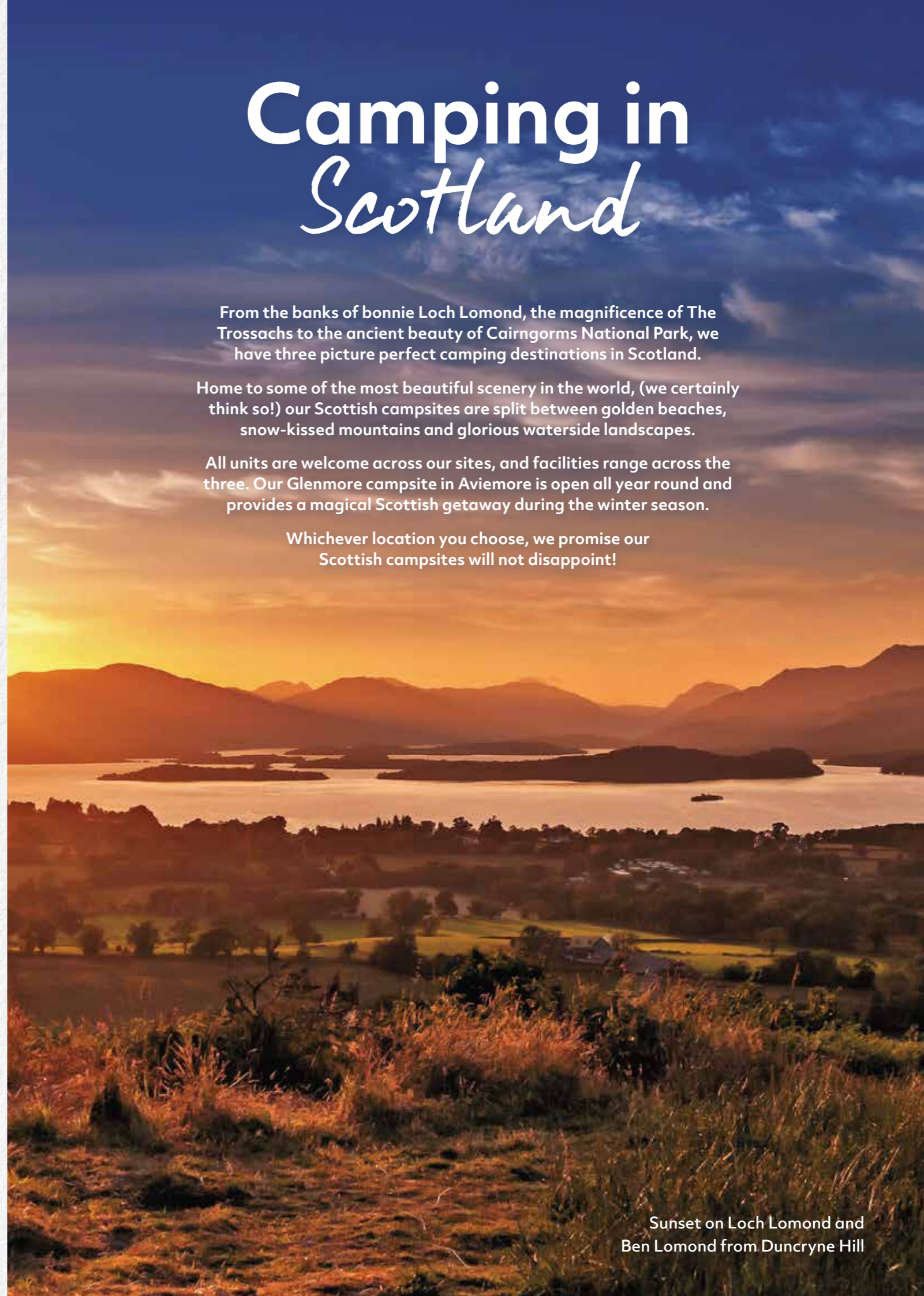
Camping in Scotland

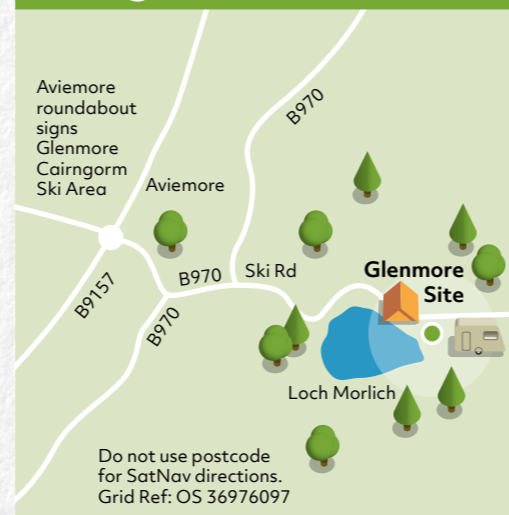

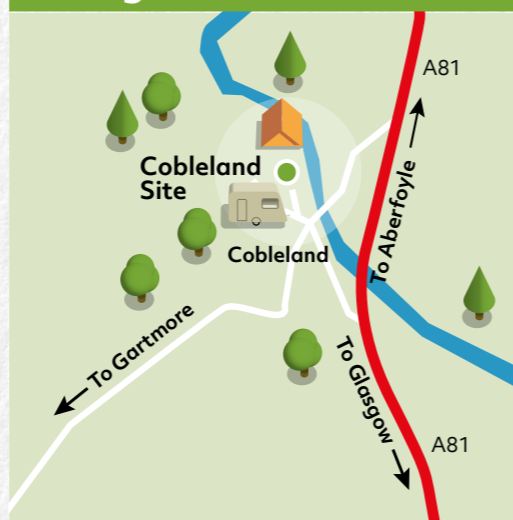
Cobleland

The site sits within the Queen Elizabeth Forest Park and is adjacent to Loch Ard Forest, which provides 21 miles of picturesque forest tracks. The River Forth runs shallow and is the ideal place for children to practise fishing, and the site sells fishing permits for the more experienced further up the river.

Aberfoyle village, lying inside the Lomond and Trossachs National Park, is just a 20 to 30-minute walk away. Stirling is a 20-minute drive away with Glasgow a little further afield at 45 minutes.
