

Access Statement – Gullivers

Your Arrival on Site

- Train station 2.5miles from site. Bus stop is approx. 5 min walk
- When nearing site follow the signs for Splash world then the camp site sign
- One keypad operated barrier that is automatic on exit. It's locked between 11pm and 7am
- Overnight parking is available just outside the reception
- Approach road is tarmac leading to loose gravel
- The visitors parking doubles as the overnight which is 10m from the main gate
- New arrivals should pull up to reception. The surface is tarmac and it's reasonably level
- There are no designated spaces and limited parking a short distance from the reception
- There is no handrail attached to the reception wall
- There are no steps
- There are potted plants along the path

Your Check in

- The reception is clearly signed for arrivals
- Reception is open 9am-11.00am then 4pm-5pm
- Follow instructions on reception door
- Level access to reception with a small 1 inch step
- A little bit narrow on entering reception
- Good clear floor space in reception
- A low level reception counter is available

Your Pitch

- Cars can be parked next to most pitches on site
- Four pitches close to the accessible room
- Loose, large gravel and stone on all hard standing pitches
- Many level hardstanding are close to the site road

Your Facilities

- There is a clear, well maintained path leading to the facilities
- Level access to all areas of the facility block
- Level access leading in to the blocks
- Level to family and accessible room
- There is no semi-ambulant cubicle in both men's and ladies
- All sinks have push button taps throughout
- There are no seats in all showers
- The showers are operated by a push button in men's ladies and the family room
- The showers have a shower tray in the gents and ladies and a shower cubicle in the family rooms
- The facility block as low level, wall mounted lights

Your Accessible Facilities

- There is a flat level paved slabs path leading to the accessible facility
- There are no handrails leading to the accessible facility
- There is flat level access in to the accessible facility
- There are handrails next to the toilet
- There is a larger size flush handle
- There is transfer space to the right of the toilet
- The wash basin can be reached from the toilet
- The washbasin has larger than normal lever top taps
- There is a hand dryer located in the room
- There is a low level mirror above the sink that does not extend to full height
- The shower has a number of handrails
- The shower is dial operated
- The shower is open access, not a cubicle
- The shower head is height adjustable
- The floor is nonslip
- There is a hair dryer
- There is an emergency chord next to the toilet and in the shower. Both can be reached from the floor
- The emergency alarm can not be heard from both staff pitches and also reception
- The accessible room can be accessed with a RADAR key

Your Laundry and Food Preparation Areas

- The laundry and food preparation areas both have level access
- The approach path is paved
- The taps are lever type
- The washing machine is front loading and can be reached from the floor
- The tumble dryers are front loading and can be reached from the floor
- There is a wall mounted iron
- There is a freestanding ironing board
- There are both indoor washing up facilities available
- All washing up sinks have lever taps
- There is an outdoor drying area with two rota dryers
- There is no low level sink in washing up area

Your Recreational Areas

- There is an indoor recreation area
- There is a paved flat area leading to this area
- There are no steps leading to the indoor recreational area
- There is a variety of seating available such as sofas and freestanding chairs
- There is an outdoor children's play area
- This is accessible over grass with no designated path
- There is a single bench overlooking the play area
- The play area has a rubber surface with no raised edges surrounding it
- This entire area is mostly open

Waste, Fire and Evacuation

- There is a level entrance up to all refuse areas
- There are no steps or kerbs restricting access to the refuse areas
- There is a waist high fence surrounding the compound
- All bins on site are waist high dust bins
- There is a fire triangle located at all water points which has unrestricted access over grass.
- The firefighting equipment is accessed over grass
- The assembly points are located in the main car park which is tarmac and the other is by the facility block
- Campers are briefed about the assembly point on arrival. There are clear signs

Miscellaneous Information

- There are no speed bumps along the main site road
- At night there is low level lighting on the outside of all blocks and the rest of the site is dimly lit by hook-up bollards
- The main reception car park can hold only two cars
- The overnight carpark can hold only two cars
- There are a small number of benches dotted around the site

Ready Camp

- There is one car parking space next to each unit. Other cars must be parked outside the site on the public car park 15 meters from the site gate
- There are designated gravel paths leading to the units
- All units on site have a single step up

Camping Pods

- There is a bark path leading to the camping pod area, they are all situated in a wood barked area apart from two and these are on grass
- Each pod has a single step up
