

Access Statement – Cambridge

Your Arrival on Site

- Train station 1 ½ miles from site. Bus stop is approx. 400m.
- There is one brown sign off the A1301 at the top of Cabbage Moor (private road)
- One keypad operated entry barrier that is automatic on exit. It's locked between 11pm and 7am
- Overnight parking is available just outside the barrier
- Tarmac with speed humps
- The visitors parking doubles as the overnight which is 10m from the main gate
- New arrivals should pull up to reception. The surface is tarmac and is level
- There are no designated accessible parking spaces
- Uneven path and one small step to reception
- Roof support pillars with potted plants along the path

Your Check in

- The reception is clearly signed for arrivals
- 9am-10:30am and 4pm-6pm
- Clear instructions on reception door when office is closed
- Uneven concrete slabs and one small step
- Slight lip on the door
- Good clear floor space in reception
- No low level reception counter, but clipboards are available

Your Pitch

- Cars can be parked next to all pitches on site
- Ten pitches of various types close to the accessible room
- Loose, large gravel on hardstanding pitches
- Complete site is level

Your Facilities

- There is a clear, level tarmac path leading to the facilities
- Kerbstone to the rear of the facility block, but level from the front
- There are two semi-ambulant shower cubicles in both men's and ladies
- All taps are push button throughout
- There are fold down seats in all showers
- The showers are operated by a push button in men's and ladies and the temperature cannot be adjusted.
- The exterior of the block is illuminated throughout the night. All internal lighting is by motion sensor

Your Accessible Facilities

- There is a flat level concrete and tarmac path leading to the accessible facility
- There is a slight lip at the door to the accessible facility
- Paddle handle lock on door
- The toilet has one drop down rail to the left and one wall mounted handrail to the right
- There is a regular size flush handle
- There is transfer space to the left of the toilet
- The wash basin can be reached from the toilet
- The washbasin has normal lever top taps
- There is a hand dryer located in the room
- There is a low level mirror above the sink that does not extend to full height
- The shower has a number of handrails
- The shower is dial operated
- The shower is open access, not a cubicle
- The shower head is height adjustable
- The floor is nonslip
- There is a hair dryer
- There is an emergency chord next to the toilet and in the shower. Both can be reached from the floor
- The emergency alarm cannot be heard from the staff pitches or reception.
- Low level hooks for clothing

Your Laundry and Food Preparation Areas

- The laundry and food preparation areas both have level access
- The approach path is concrete
- The taps are push button
- The washing machine is front loading and can be reached from the floor
- The tumble dryer is front loading and stacked on top of the washing machine
- There is a wall mounted iron
- There is a wall mounted ironing board
- There are outdoor washing up facilities available
- All washing up sinks have push button taps
- There is an outdoor drying area with a rotary line
- There is one low level sink in both the outdoor washing up area and laundry room

Your Recreational Areas

- There is no recreation area
- There is an outdoor children play area
- This is accessible over grass with no designated path
- The play area has a rubber flat surface

Waste, Fire and Evacuation

- One kerbstone between facility block and the refuse area, which is on tarmac roadway
- All bins on site are full height industrial 1100L units
- There is a fire triangle located at all water points which has unrestricted access over grass
- The firefighting equipment is accessed over grass
- The assembly points are located in the main car park which is tarmacked and the other is in the far camping field which is grass

Miscellaneous Information

- There are speed bumps along all site roads, there are also four speed bumps on the approach road leading to site
- At night there is lighting on the outside of all blocks, and the rest of the site is dimly lit by hook-up bollards
- The main reception car park can hold at least ten cars
- There are a small number of picnic benches in the far camping field, plus two benches near reception

Ready Camp

- There is one car parking space next to each unit. Other cars must be parked in main car park
- There are no designated paths leading to the units, access is all over grass
- All three units have a single step up to the decking
