

Access Statement – Crowden

Your Arrival on Site

- Train station 5 miles from site. Bus stop is approx. 5 miles
- There are two brown signs off the A628, one large site sign at entrance
- One keypad operated barrier that is automatic on exit. It's locked between 11pm and 7am
- Overnight parking is available opposite reception
- Tarmac leading to loose gravel
- The visitors parking doubles as the overnight which is 1m from the main gate
- New arrivals should park opposite reception. The surface is gravel and it's reasonably level
- There are no designated spaces but plenty of spaces a short, level distance from the reception
- There is no handrail needed at reception
- No steps but a gentle incline
- Potted plants along the path and on the fences

Your Check in

- The reception is clearly signed for arrivals
- Reception is open between 9am-10:30am then 4.30pm-6pm
- There is a bell located on the reception door which is connected to an on duty team member
- Level concrete slabs
- Slight lip on the door
- Good clear floor space in reception
- Low level reception counter

Your Pitch

- Cars can be parked next to most pitches on site
- Four pitches close to the facilities
- Many level hardstanding with grass pitches are close to the site road

Your Facilities

- There is a clear, well maintained path leading to the facilities
- Two small steps to the gents and one small step into the ladies, but level from the front
- All sinks have push taps throughout
- There are fold down seats in all showers
- The showers are operated by a dial in men's and ladies
- The showers have a step in
- The facility block as low level, wall mounted lights
- There is a hair dryer in the ladies

Your Accessible Facilities

- There are no dedicated accessible facilities on site

Your Laundry and Food Preparation Areas

- The drying room is temperature controlled and located next to the pot washing area
- The approach path is Stone slabs
- All washing up sinks have screw top taps

Your Recreational Areas

- There are no dedicated recreational areas on site

Waste, Fire and Evacuation

- There are no steps of kerbs restricting access to the refuse areas
- All bins on site are full height industrial 1100L units by the main entrance. 1.2m high
- There is a fire triangle located at all water points which has unrestricted accessed over grass
- The firefighting equipment is accessed over grass
- The assembly points are located by the main entrance which is loose gravel and the other is by the ladies toilets which is grass
- Campers are briefed about the assembly point on arrival. There are clear signs

Miscellaneous Information

- There is a 5 mph speed limit on site
- At night there is low level lighting on the outside of all blocks and the rest of the site is dimly lit by hook-up bollards
- The overnight carpark can hold at about six cars
- There are a small number of benches dotted around the site

Camping Pods

- There is a bark path leading to all camping pods.
- Each pod has a single step up
