

Access Statement – Blackmore

Your Arrival on Site

- Train station is 4.5 miles from the site. Bus is 400 yards to the right of site near the church
- Council brown signs at the end of roads, CC&C sign at top of drive
- There is a coded barrier, gates are locked to vehicles between 11pm and 7am
- The approach road is tarmac
- When site barriers are locked overnight please use car park near reception
- On arrival please pull over to the left of the barrier; the tarmac road has a slight incline
- There is no designated accessible parking
- There are no handrails leading to reception
- There are no steps or steep inclines

Your Check in

- The reception is clearly signed
- The reception opening hours are 9am – 10.30am and 4pm – 17.30pm
- Please ring doorbell out of hours
- There is level access leading to reception
- There are no specific access issues
- The floor is clear from clutter

Your Pitch

- One car per pitch can be parked next to units
- There are a number of hardstanding pitches located near the accessible facility
- Hardstanding pitches are gravel
- There are a number of level pitches that are close to facility blocks

Your Facilities

- There is a clear, well maintained path leading to the facilities
- There are no steps or ramps leading to the facility block
- There is level access in to the facility block
- There is no semi-ambulant cubicle
- There are a mixture of screw top and push button taps throughout
- There are seats within the shower
- The showers are a mixture of dial and push button operated
- Showers have level access
- The facility block is lit at night

Your Accessible Facilities

- There is a flat level path leading to the accessible facility
- There are no handrails leading to the accessible facility
- There is flat level access in to the accessible facility
- The toilet has handrails
- The toilet has a larger flush handle
- There is transfer space both sides of the toilet
- The washbasin can be reached from the toilet
- The taps are lever topped
- There is a hand dryer
- There is no full-length mirror
- The shower has handrails
- The shower is dial operated
- The shower head is height adjustable
- The floor is non-slip
- There is no hair dryer
- There is an emergency chord that can be reached from the floor
- The alarm can be heard from the staff pitches but not reception

Your Laundry and Food Preparation Areas

- All these areas have good level access
- Surfaces are tarmac.
- Taps are mixture of lever top and push button
- Washing machines are front loading
- At least one washing machine can be loaded from the floor
- The tumble drier is a stack and can be loaded above the washing machine (and not from the floor)
- There is a wall mounted iron
- There is a wall mounted ironing board
- A mixture of push button and screw top taps
- There is an outdoor drying area

Your Recreational Areas

- There is an indoor recreational area
- Access is level
- A number of chairs are available
- There is an outdoor children's play area
- Access to it is flat and level
- There is no seating available near the play area
- The surface of the play area is rubber
- There is a raised edge surrounding the play area

Waste, Fire and Evacuation

- There is flat level access leading to the refuse area
- The path is tarmac
- There is no step or kerb
- There are no handrails leading to the compound
- There are fire triangles on site
- There is unrestricted access to all firefighting equipment
- The assembly point is next to reception and near exit barrier
- The assembly point surface is tarmac and grass

Miscellaneous Information

- There are speed bumps on site
- The site is dark around pitches, but reception and facilities are well lit.
- The reception carpark will hold 13 cars
- The overnight carpark will hold 13 cars

Ready Camp

- Parking is available next to each unit
- There is no designated paths leading to the units
- There is no more than one step leading in to the units
